Business Reasons for Sametime

Sametime Pricing

Sametime is licensed two ways:

- **Unlimited Extranet Users** - By Server
 - Licensed as an unlimited group of users - single charge for unlimited users

You do not need to buy a Domino Server License

- If Sametime is the only Domino-based application
- Copy of Domino for iSeries is shipped with Sametime Media Pack

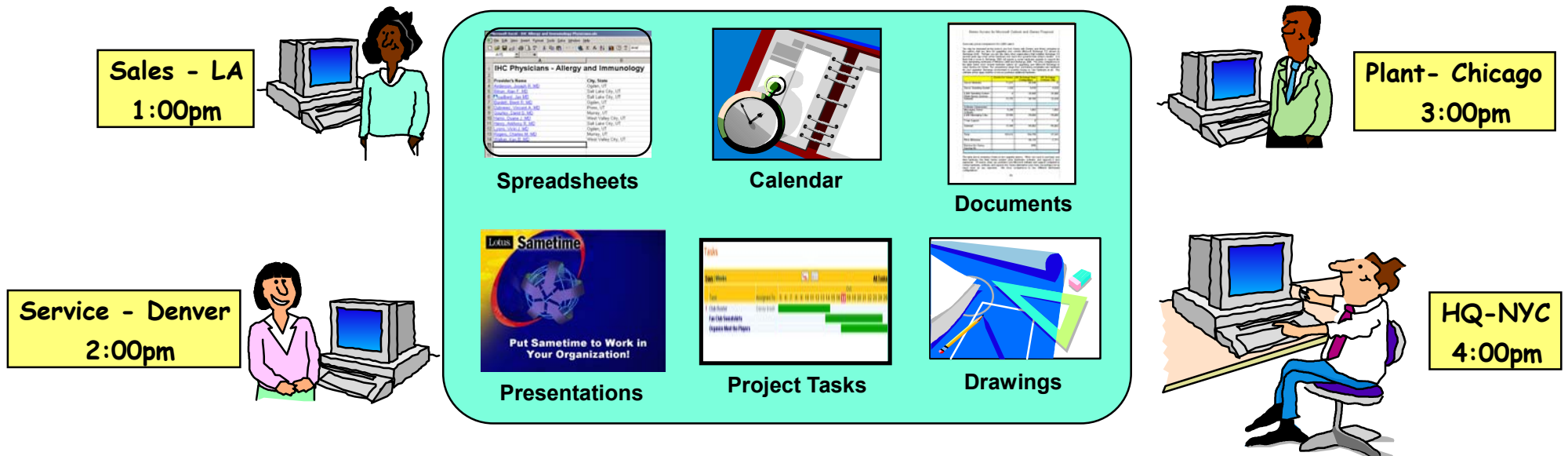

Integrating QuickPlace and Sametime

Three major steps!

- Prepare the Quickplace and Sametime Servers
- Set up Sametime Awareness and Chat for QuickPlace
- Setup Sametime meetings for QuickPlace

- Prepare Server
- Set up chat for QuickPlace
- Set up meetings for Quickplace

Preparing the QuickPlace and Sametime servers

Things to think about

- Use Domino 5.0.10 or Domino 5.0.11 if installing both in the same LPAR
- You should install QuickPlace and Sametime on two separate Domino servers
- The QuickPlace and Sametime server must reside in the same DNS domain and behind a firewall
- Both servers must have Single Sign on enabled in their Domino Server documents
- Both servers must be configured to connect to the same LDAP directory
 - ▶ Can enable LDAP on an existing Domino server
 - ▶ Can use a different LDAP server
 - ▶ Can use LDAP on Sametime server but not QuickPlace server
- If you already have a **Domino server for mail...**
 - ▶ You can use it for the user directory (just enable LDAP)
 - ▶ Do not add Sametime or QuickPlace to this server!

- Prepare Server
- Set up chat for QuickPlace

Preparing the QuickPlace and Sametime servers-continued

Things to **do**-Configure Sametime and QuickPlace servers

■ For **Sametime**:

- ▶ Follow steps outline in *Installing and Managing Sametime 3.0 for iSeries*
- ▶ For a new Sametime server, specify LDAP as the user directory and enter the fully qualified host name of the LDAP server you have selected
- ▶ If you plan to put your LDAP server on the same Domino server as you are running Sametime delete the LDAP document created in the Directory Assistance Database (DA.NSF).

■ For **QuickPlace**:

- ▶ Follow instructions in *Installing and Managing QuickPlace 3.0 for iSeries*
 - Add a Domino server to an existing Domino domain
- ▶ When prompted for an administrator username and password, specify a name that does not already exist in the LDAP user directory (for example, qpadmin)
- ▶ Configure the QuickPlace server to use the same external (LDAP) directory as the Sametime server

■ Ensure replication between the two servers.

- Prepare Server
- Set up chat for QuickPlace
- Set up meetings for Quickplace

Preparing the QuickPlace and Sametime servers-continued

Things to **do**-on the Sametime server

- Test the Sametime server
 - ▶ Ensure that Chat and the Meeting server are working correctly.
- Install the Sametime toolkits
 - ▶ You'll need the files for the QuickPlace server
 - ▶ See *Installing and Managing Sametime for iSeries* for details
- One the **Sametime server**, configure a Web Single Signon Document
 - ▶ Used for Lightweight Third Party Authentication (LTPA) and passes authentication between Sametime and QuickPlace servers
 - ▶ Add the QuickPlace server name to this document
- But wait...there's more...

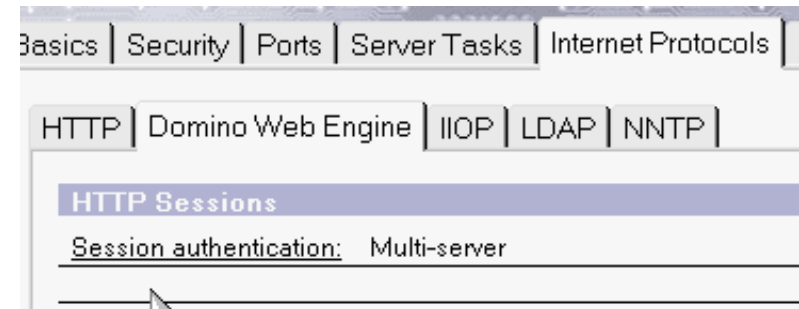

Preparing the QuickPlace and Sametime servers-continued

Things to do-On the QuickPlace server

- Set the Session Authentication to Multi-Server
 - ▶ Located in the server document under **Internet Protocols->Domino Web Engine-> Session Authentication**
- Modify the Notes.ini file by adding:
 - ▶ NoWebFileSystemACLs=1
 - ▶ h_ScopeURLInQP=1
- Use the Notes client to Create a Domino Config Document using the DOMCFG5.NTF template
 - ▶ Create a new Login Mapping document in this database
 - ▶ Set the following fields:
 - Target Database = QUICKPLACE/RESOURCES.NSF
 - Target Form = QuickPlaceLoginForm

"Point" the QuickPlace server to the Sametime server

On the QuickPlace server:

- Specify a Sametime server for Chat and Meetings
- Sign on as the QuickPlace Administrator
 - ▶ Click **Server Settings, Other Options, Edit Options**
 - ▶ Under the Sametime Servers heading, enter the fully qualified name of the Sametime server
 - ▶ Save the document
- Enter a place and verify that Awareness is working
- Test Chat!

Sametime Servers. To enable real-time collaboration features in QuickPlace Community Server that will provide awareness and instant messaging services, you must specify a Sametime server that will provide meeting services. The same Sametime server can be used for both chat and meetings. To disable the features, you must specify a null value.

Setup Sametime meetings for QuickPlace

Just a few more files to copy and settings to change!

- Create a "phantom user" for Sametime and QuickPlace integration
 - ▶ This user should only be used for Sametime and QuickPlace
- Modify the ACL of the STCONFIG.NSF Database

Setup Sametime meetings for QuickPlace

On the QuickPlace server:

- Create a directory for the Sametime meeting files in the QuickPlace directory
 - ▶ For example /STMTG
- If necessary, change the owner to QNOTES
- Copy three files from the /Sametime directory on the Sametime server to the STMTG directory on the QuickPlace server
 - ▶ STMTgManagement.jar
 - ▶ STCore.jar
 - ▶ IBMjsse.jar

- ✓ Prepare Server
- ✓ Set up chat for QuickPlace
- ➔ Set up meetings for Quickplace

Setup Sametime meetings for QuickPlace

On the QuickPlace server:

- Modify the QuickPlace server settings
 - ▶ Modify the QuickPlace server INI file
 - Add the following lines to the Notes.Ini file:
 - ST1=/STMtg/stmtgmanagement.jar
 - ST2=/STMtg/stcore.jar
 - ST3=/STMtg/ibmjssse.jar
 - Modify the following line in the Notes ini file:
 - JavaUserClassesExt=LQPJava1,LQPJava2,LQPJava3,LQPJava4,LQPJava5,ST1,ST2,ST3

- Create a QPCONFIG.XML file

- ▶ Modify the QuickPlace server settings




