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### **Minimum System Requirements**

- PC:
  - High Speed Internet Connection: Cable or DSL
  - Operating System: Windows XP (Service Pack 2)

OR Windows 2000 (Service Pack 4)

**OR Windows Vista** 

- Computer Processor: 800MHz Pentium III or Athlon, or better
- Computer Memory: 256MB or better
- Video/Graphics Card:

nVidia GeForce 2, GeForce 4mx, or better

OR ATI Radeon 8500, 9250, or better

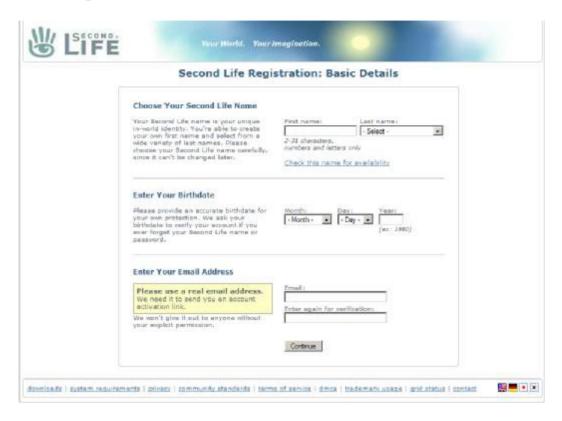

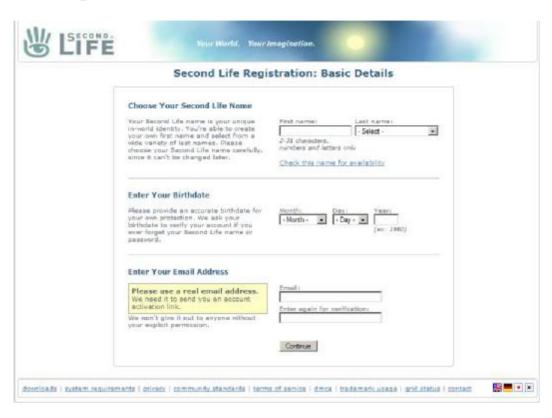
- Enter a fictional first name and select a last name from the list

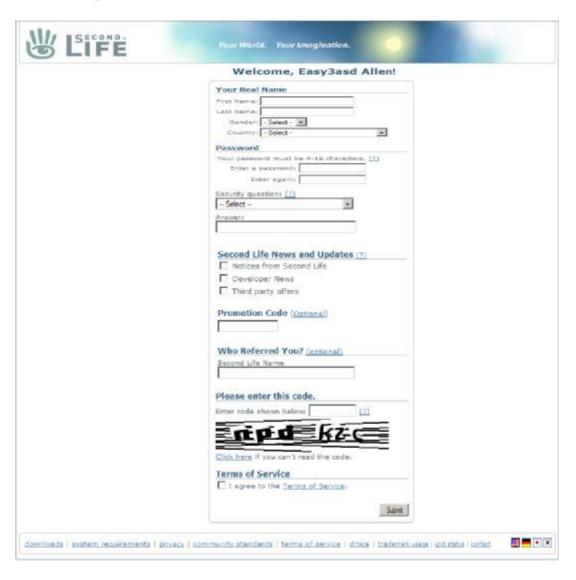

- You are able to change your appearence later





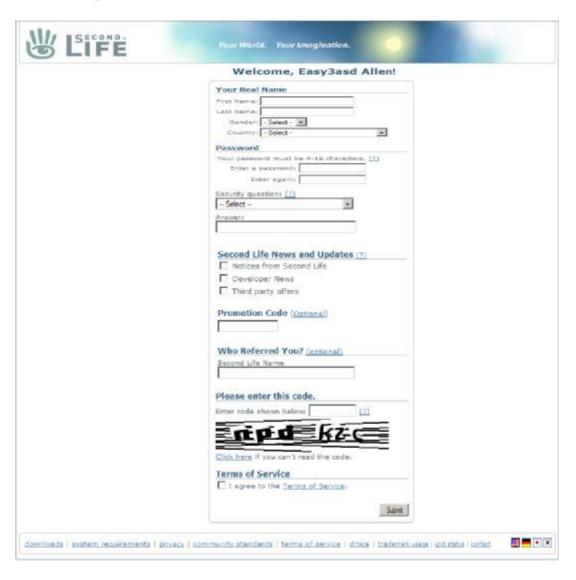

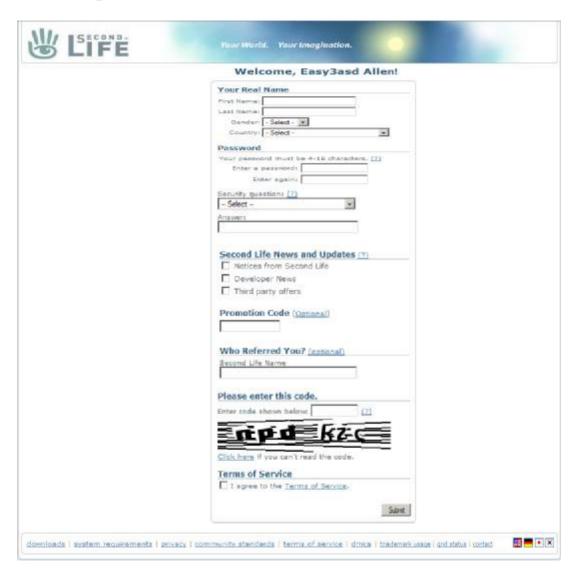

 Accept the Term of Service and click "Submit"





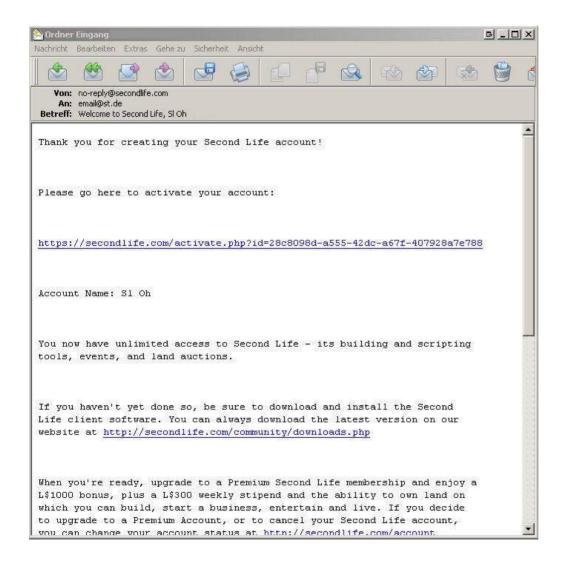
 To create a priceless account click "Skip this step"

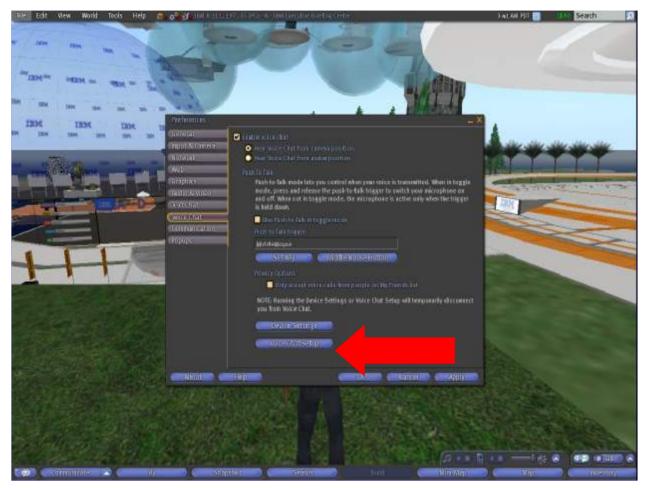

#### **Get Connected – Voice Chat - Setup**

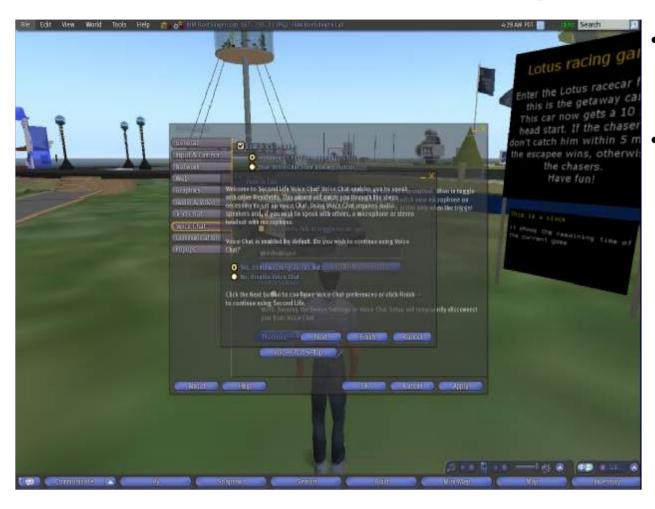


- To be able to listen to the session, you have to enable the voice chat feature
- Open ,,Edit" ,,Preferences"
- Open the "Voice Chat" tab
- Run Voice Chat Setup

Note: To be able to listen to the session, you have to enable the voice chat feature. However, once you've activated this feature, be sure to disable the 'talk' feature so that you don't disturb other listeners during the broadcast.



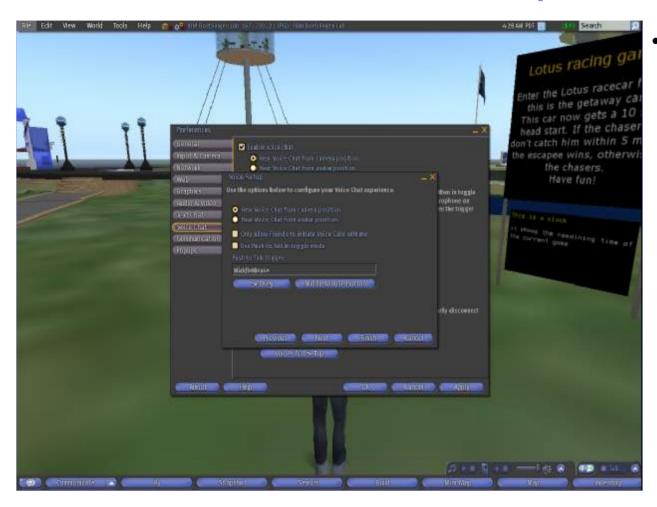
## **Get Connected – Voice Chat – Setup Wizzard**



- Use the Wizzard to configure VoiceChat and adjust your microphone level
- You only need a microphone if you want to let your avatar "speak" with your voice. To be able to listen, you do NOT need a microphone.



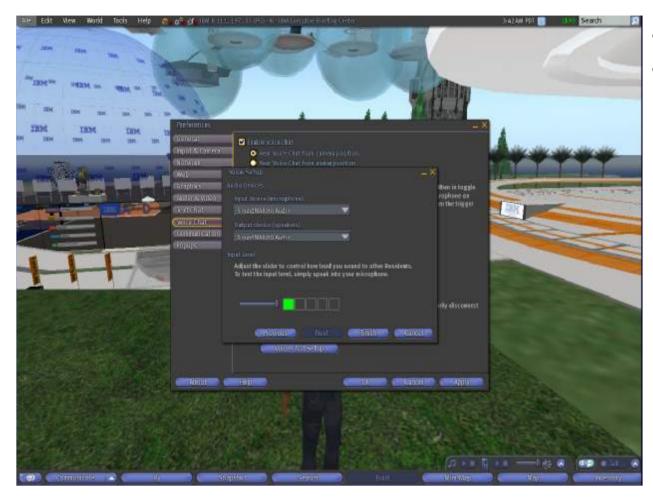
## **Get Connected – Voice Chat – Setup Wizzard**



Configure features and select key to trigger voice on/off



## **Get Connected – Voice Chat – Setup Wizzard**



- Adjust the microphone level
- Red indicates ,,too loud"



#### **Get Connected – Voice Chat - Activation**



- Besides the toggle/activation key (push to talk) voice can be transmitted permanently via the "Talk" button at the bottom of the screen
- Please DISABLE this feature during the session to not disturb the other listeners



#### **Get Connected – Voice Chat – Visual Indicator**



- There is a small white spot above an avatar to indicate that voice is enabled
- The green "radio waves" indicate, that sound is transmittet
- There might be a delay until voice is activated!



#### **Get Connected – Voice Chat – Visual Indicator**



Red "radio waves" indicate "too loud" and probable the others can't understand what you are saying



## **Get Connected – Voice Chat – Active Speakers**



- There is a dialog, where you can see avatars listed, which are voice enabled
- There is a choice to restrict transmission to a subgroup only
- In this dialog you can mute avatars which disturb you



#### **How to communicate - Gestures**



- To do a little bit of interaction with your avatar, you can let him do some gestures
- Click on the "Gestures" menu and choose a gesture
- The "/hey" gesture will let your avatar **wink**
- The "/clap" gesture will let your avatar **clap**



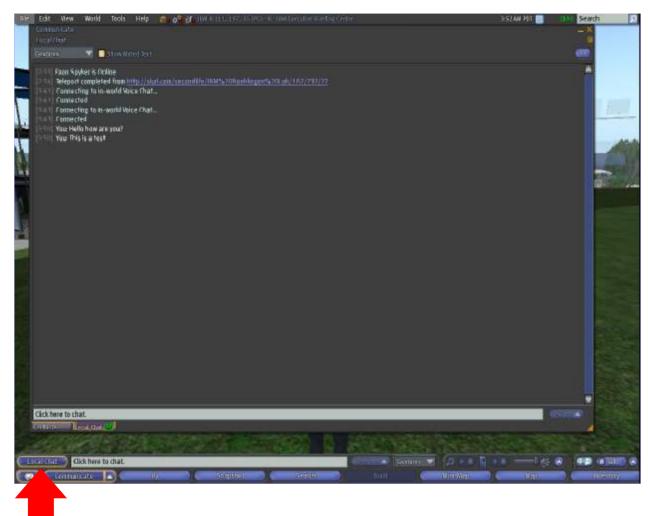
### **How to communicate - Chat**



- If you do not want to use the voice feature, you can use chat
- Just click the button at the lower left corner and enter what you want to say
- Click "Say" to let your avatar say what you have typed.
   Be aware, only avatars near to you can "hear" you



#### **How to communicate - Chat**



- Via Local Chat button and then Local Chat at the bottom of the pop-up screen again.
   You can have a look who said what and when ...
- Can be saved to disk automatically



## **Get Informed - Close-Ups**



- Pressing the <Alt> key
   provides cameracontrol via
   mouse movement
- Focus is the mouse position
- Back-Forth = Zoom
- Left-Right = Rotate



# **Get Informed - Close-Ups**



- Try to read something from far away
- Look at yourself
- Gadget: Focus on a person and you view will automatically follow



#### **Get Informed – Camera Controls**



- Sometime mouse controlled view is hard to handle
- There is a set of camara controls, which can be used in addition



### **Get Informed – Camera Controls / Avatar Controls**



Similar controls exist for person movement as well



# **Get Interactive – Use Objects**



- The mouse cursor indicates possible interactions with the world
- activate objects
- follow URLs to 2D
- buy something



#### **Get Interactive - Menu Driven**



- Right click brings up a menu
- Works everywhere
- Menuitems might be different but structure is the same



# **Get Interactive – You'll pick up lot's of "Things"**



- Often you get offered something
- This is not a problem, if you have to pay – you must confirm
- Things end up in your inventory



### **Get Interactive – Inventory**



- Under Resent Items you will find the new stuff
- In parallel it is put under All itmes in "My Inventory"
- Housekeeping is important



## **Get Personalized – Stranger Items in Inventory**



- Everything is in your inventory
- BodyParts
  - Hair
  - Eyes
  - **..**.
- Landmarks!



# **Get Personalized – Change your Appearance**



- Right click on yourself
- Menu Appearance



### **Get Personalized – Virtual Body "Clay in you hands"**



- Your Avatar is your virtual identity
- Even if you take the standard – you make a statement
- Almost anything can be changed
- Think about your "Image"



# Get Personalized – Get dressed up (or down)



- It is not hard to make some personal clothes
- Start with a T-Shirt or a Jacket and use the dialogs



### **Get Personalized – Shape to Reality or Fantasy**



- It is possible to get a look-alike Avatar
- Most important
  - Gender
  - Size
  - Head and Face
- Sometimes it is desired to get recognized VR=RL



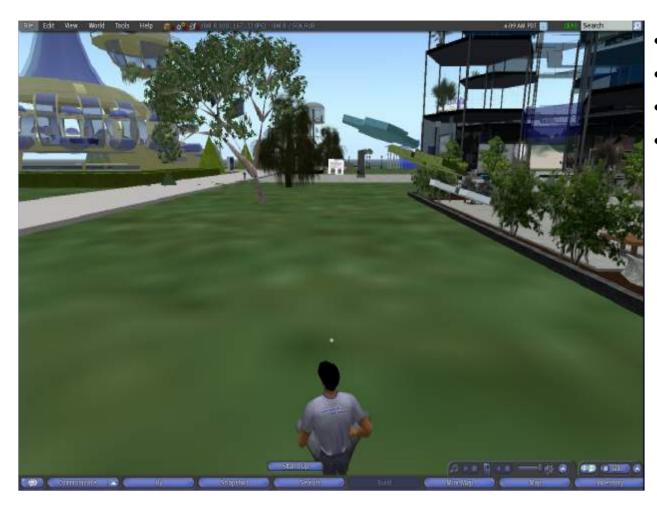
### **Get Relaxed – Take a seat ...**
