Atlas is a z/OS RESTful web service and deployment architecture for z/OS microservices. Atlas is implemented as a Liberty Profile web application that uses z/OSMF services to provide a range of APIs for the management of jobs, data sets, UNIX System Services (USS) files, and persistent data.

- New APIs in USS File APIs
 - POST /Atlas/api/uss/files to create new USS directories and files
 - DELETE /Atlas/api/uss/files{path} to delete USS directories and files
 - GET /Atlas/api/files/{path} to get a list of files in a USS directory along with their attributes
 - PUT /Atlas/api/files/{path}/content to update the content of a USS file
- New features in the Dataset Explorer
 - Edit sequential data sets and partitioned dataset members with basic syntax highlighting and content assist for JCL and REXX.
 - Conduct basic validation of record length when editing JCL.

- New features in the UNIX file Explorer
 - List files and folders.
 - Create new files and folders.
 - Edit files with basic syntax highlighting and content assist for JCL and REXX.
 - Delete files and folders.
