

Sample usage:

```
ContextWriter cw = new ContextWriter();
for (...) {
    String testLabel = ... // test name
    ContextWriter.Test t = cw.start(testLabel);
    ...
    // run test
    ...
    t.stop();
}
File file = ... // output file
cw.write(file);
```

Example output:

```
[{"offset":0,"session":[{"STOP":1598903879631,"LABEL":"Login-
test","START":1598903879513},{"STOP":1598903880631,"LABEL":"Logoff-
test","START":1598903879631}], "appserver":""}]
```

Notes: The user would create a ContextWriter and call start/stop methods (with a label) around their tests and then write to a file when they're done. The utility takes care of the timestamps/JSON formatting and does not require any additional libraries.
