#### 1.0 Introduction

This program directory is intended for the system programmer responsible for program installation and maintenance. It contains information concerning the material and procedures associated with the installation of **Query Management Facility for VSE/ESA Version 06** (abbreviated to QMF for VSE in this document). You should read all of this program directory before installing the program, and then keep it for future reference.

The program directory contains the following sections:

- 2.0, "Program Materials" on page 2 identifies the basic and optional program materials and documentation for QMF for VSE.
- 3.0, "Program Support" on page 5 describes the IBM support available for QMF for VSE.
- 4.0, "Program and Service Level Information" on page 6 lists the APARs (program level) and PTFs (service level) incorporated into QMF for VSE.
- 5.0, "Installation Requirements and Considerations" on page 7 identifies the resources and considerations for installing and using QMF for VSE.
- 6.0, "Installation Instructions" on page 10 provides information on installation and activation of QMF for VSE.

Before installing QMF for VSE, read 3.2, "Preventive Service Planning" on page 5. This section tells you how to find any updates to the information and procedures in this program directory.

Installation requirements and procedures specific installing this licensed program in a VSE environment are described. This product must be installed using Maintain System History Program (MSHP).

## 2.0 Program Materials

An IBM program is identified by a program number and a feature code. The program number for QMF for VSE is 5648-A70.

The program announcement material describes the features supported by QMF for VSE. Ask your IBM marketing representative for this information, if you have not already received a copy.

#### 2.1 Basic Machine-Readable Material

The distribution medium for this program is as follows:

The QMF for VSE tape contains all of the programs and data needed for installation. QMF for VSE is installed using MSHP. See section 6.0, "Installation Instructions" on page 10 for more information about how to install QMF for VSE. Figure 1 describes the tape for QMF for VSE. Figure 3 on page 3 describes the file content of the program tape.

If you ordered QMF for VSE with QMF for Windows, you will receive one tape for QMF for VSE on one of the distribution mediums indicated above. In addition you will receive one CD-ROM for QMF for Windows Version 06. The QMF for VSE tape contains all the programs and data needed for installation. QMF for VSE is installed using MSHP. See section 6.0, "Installation Instructions" on page 10 for more information about how to install QMF for VSE. Figure 2 on page 3 describes the tape for QMF for VSE when ordered with QMF for Windows. Figure 3 on page 3 describes the file content of the program tape. The CD-ROM contains all of the programs and data needed for installation. Refer to the README.TXT file in the root directory on the CD-ROM for information about the CD-ROM and installation instructions.

## 4.0 Program and Service Level Information

#### 5.2.2 Machine Requirements

VMESA\* or ESA mode supervisor capabilities are required to run QMF for VSE.

### 5.2.3 System Considerations

The following installation requirements must be observed:

- The VSE system must be equipped with a tape drive for the type of distribution tape ordered.
