1.0 Introduction

This program directory is intended for the system programmer responsible for program installation and maintenance. It contains information concerning the material and procedures associated with the installation of a **Query Management Facility for VSE/ESA Version 6 National Language Feature** (abbreviated to QMF NLF in this document). You should read all of this program directory before installing the program, and then keep it for future reference.

The program directory contains the following sections:

- 2.0, "Program Materials" on page 2 identifies the basic and optional program materials and documentation for QMF NLF.
- 3.0, "Program Support" on page 10 describes the IBM support available for QMF NLF.
- 4.0, "Program and Service Level Information" on page 12 lists the APARs (program level) and PTFs (service level) incorporated into QMF NLF.
- 5.0, "Installation Requirements and Considerations" on page 13 identifies the resources and considerations for installing and using QMF NLF.
- 6.0, "Installation Instructions" on page 15 provides information on installation and activation of QMF NLF.

Before installing QMF NLF, read 3.2, "Preventive Service Planning" on page 10. This section tells you how to find any updates to the information and procedures in this program directory.

Installation requirements and procedures specific installing this licensed program in a VSE environment are described. This product must be installed using Maintain System History Program (MSHP).

2.0 Program Materials

An IBM program is identified by a program number and a feature code. The program number for QMF NLF is 5648-A70.

2.1 Basic Machine-Readable Material

The distribution medium for this program is as follows:

- One 9 track magnetic tape (written at 6250 BPI) or
- One 1/4" tape cartridge

The tape contains all the programs and data needed for installation. QMF NLF is installed using MSHP. See 6.0, "Installation Instructions" on page 15 for more information about how to install the program. Figure 1 describes the tape. Figure 3 on page 6 describes the file content of the program tape.

If you ordered the QMF NLF with QMF for Windows, you will receive one tape for the QMF NLF on one of the distribution mediums indicated above. In addition you will receive one CD-ROM for QMF for Windows Version 6. The QMF NLF tape contains all the programs and data needed for installation. QMF NLF is installed using MSHP. See section 6.0, "Installation Instructions" on page 15 for more information about how to install QMF NLF. Figure 2 on page 4 describes the tape for the QMF NLF when ordered with QMF for Windows. Figure 3 on page 6 describes the file content of the program tape. The CD-ROM contains all of the programs and data needed for installation. Refer to the README.TXT file in the root directory on the CD-ROM for information about the CD-ROM and installation instructions.

4.0 Program and Service Level Information

5.0 Installation Requirements and Considerations

5.1 System Requirements

This section describes the environment of the target system required to install and use QMF NLF.

5.1.1 Operating System Requirements

A QMF NLF requires the same operating system that the QMF for VSE V6 base product was installed on. For Version 6, you can install QMF on any processor supported by VSE/ESA 2.2 or higher.

5.1.2 Hardware Requirements

The QMF NLF panels and messages contain National Language characters. Use of the feature requires terminals using the national language codepage, national language keyboards and appropriate machine logic.

One tape drive supported by VSE/ESA is required for installation.

5.2 Prerequisite Programs

You must install the QMF for VSE V6 base product prior to installing a QMF NLF. All product requisities of QMF for VSE V6 base are also product requisites of QMF NLF. For details, see the list of base product requisites in the QMF for VSE V6 base product program directory.

5.2.1 DASD Storage Requirements

Follow the instructions in *Installing and Managing QMF on VSE/ESA*, GC26-9574.

5.2.2 Machine Requirements

VMESA* or ESA mode supervisor capabilities are required to run QMF NLF.

- The VSE system must be equipped with a tape drive for the type of distribution tape ordered.
