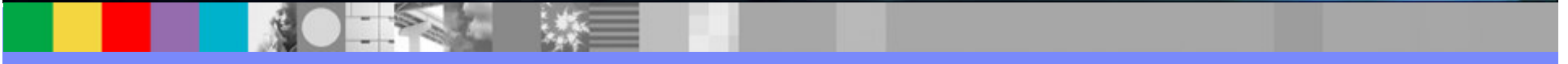

- The number of virtual workers has increased by a whopping **800%** over the past five years.

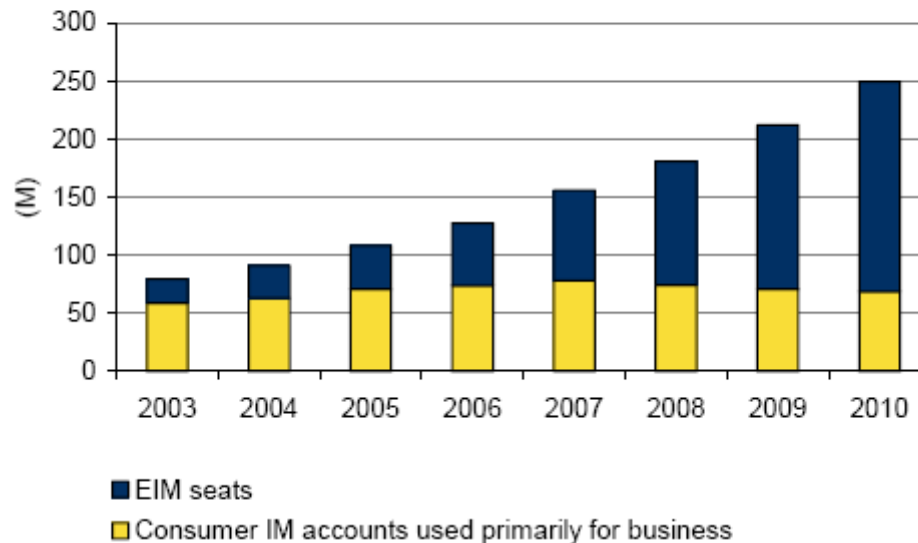

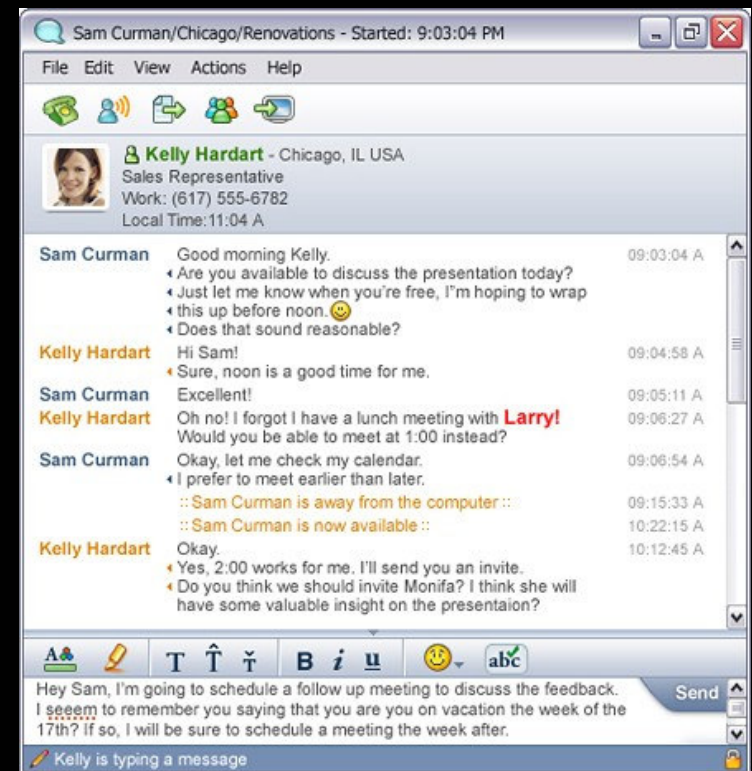
Worldwide Business Instant Messaging Accounts, 2003–2010:

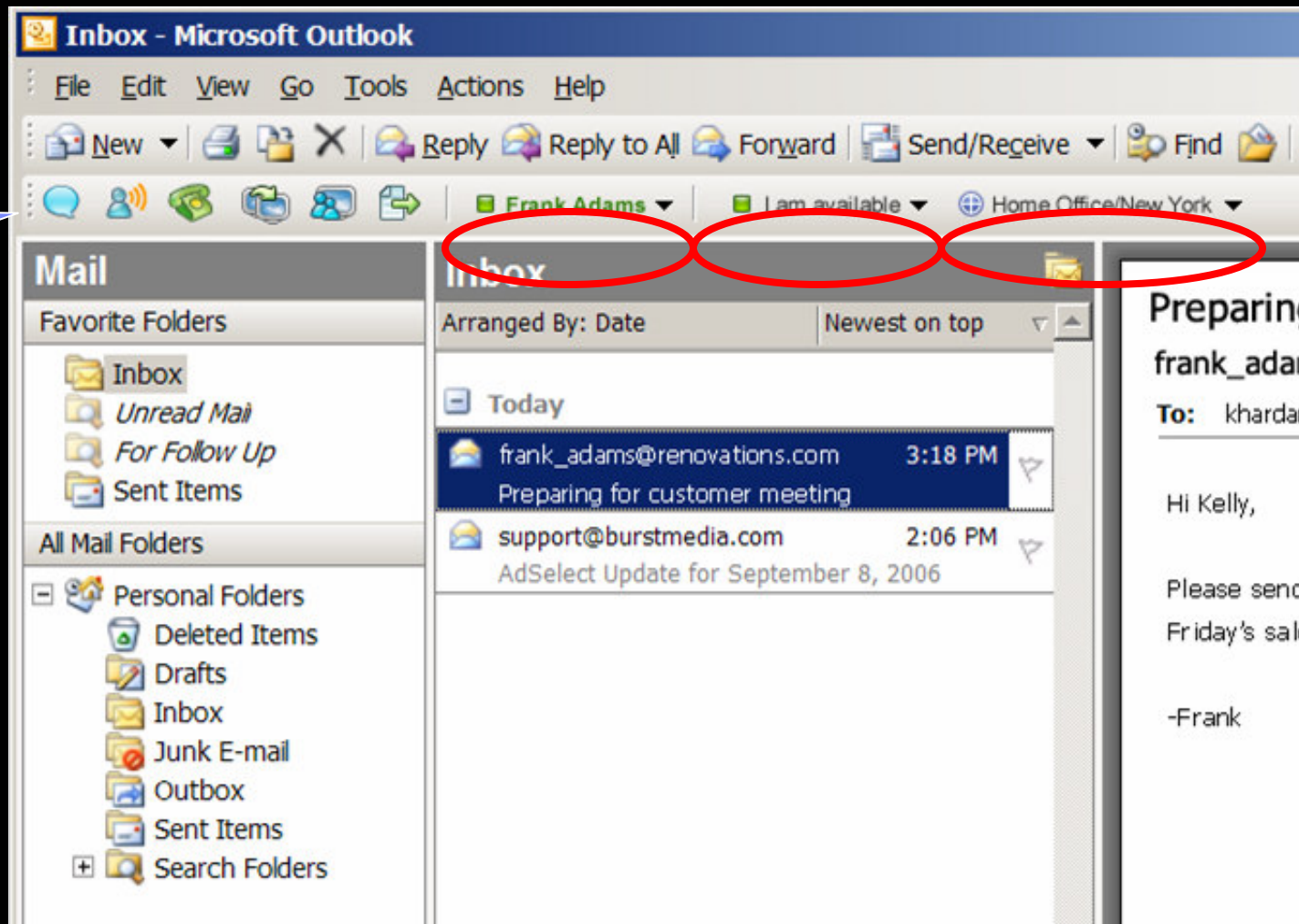


Lotus Sametime 7.5.1 – Tabbed Chat interface
