In this scenario, an engineer uses a CAD tool to create drawings for new parts to fix several operational problems with a product. He stores the drawings as documents on the Enovia SmarTeam server. He also creates the parts and a Bill of Materials, linking the CAD drawings to each part.

Procurement and sourcing personnel using the ERP system need this production information to communicate it to suppliers and partners. The engineer is able to transfer the documents from Enovia SmarTeam to a temporary area. IBM WebSphere Business Integration Server Express Plus monitors this area and copies the new documents to a location the ERP system can access. When new information is entered into the ERP system it is also automatically synchronized to the product lifecycle management system.
