





2. Recertification Requirements – iSeries and pSeries

- Significant technology announcements in eServer i5 and p5 required significant update of existing certifications
- New contractual requirements were introduced for Business Partners selling iSeries and pSeries servers to become certified at the i5 and p5 levels
 - Minimum of one new Sales and one new Technical certification required for each series
- Deadline for recertification is July 31, 2005 for both iSeries and pSeries partners



Additional Certification Considerations

- Firm level qualification to sell eServer i5 595 servers
- Firm level qualification to sell eServer p5 enterprise servers
- For Business Development Initiative (BDI) there are additional requirements (eServer i5 iSeries program)
- PartnerWorld Advanced/Premier levels have additional certification requirements



iSeries and pSeries Recertification Status Update - IBM North America Business Partners as of January 01, 2005

- Focus Now Required by Business Partners
- Significant % Not Yet Meeting Recertification Requirements
- For Those Business Partners not Meeting July 31, 2005 Deadline
 - IBM Authorization to Market will be Terminated
 - Business Partners will have to wait 12 months to reapply to market iSeries or pSeries products



3. Becoming a Subject Matter Expert

Test Development Process

- Certification test development follows a rigorous process. The process is comprised of questions that are valid for the job role, and are perceived the same way by a diverse group of candidates.
 - Job Role Definition
 - Job Task Analysis
 - Examination "Blueprint" Development
 - Item (Question) Development
 - Item Review
 - Test Review
 - Standard Setting
 - Test Publication
 - Test Statistical Analysis and Revision
- Subject Matter Experts drive all phases of development





The involvement of SMEs is key to a sound certification program

- SMEs bring a number of critical elements to the development process
 - Work Experience
 - Technical Expertise
 - Job Knowledge
 - Willingness to learn and contribute
- With guidance from a measurement consultant, SMEs help create a high-quality certification program
- Both Business Partner and IBM Internal SMEs from around the world are involved in the development of exams
- SMEs earn exam credit for participating in development; expenses reimbursed by IBM in accordance with IBM's guidelines for travel to workshops... IBM recognition for participation



What do we look for in SME candidates?

- Experience relevant to the job role being tested
 - Are you performing these tasks, or some of these tasks, today?
 - Do you interface with people performing the job?
- Do you have other certifications that relate to the job role being tested?
 - Certifications from companies or organizations such as Linux, Microsoft, Lotus, Comptia, VMware, other IBM
- Worldwide viewpoint
- Trustworthy
- Willing to invest time and effort
