

ODBC Drivers - Workstation

Overview These instructions explain how to install the optional ODBC database drivers for Gentran:Server Workstation. They are a supplement to the *Gentran:Server Workstation Getting Started Guide*. Please refer to this guide for system requirements and all other installation information for Gentran:Server Workstation 6.1.

Installing the ODBC Drivers on the Workstation

Introduction To install the optional ODBC database drivers, you run the Windows program setup.exe from the Workstation ODBC Drivers installation CD.

Before you begin You must first install the core Gentran:Server Workstation software before you can install the optional ODBC database drivers. See "How to Install Gentran:Server Workstation" in the *Gentran:Server Workstation Getting Started Guide*.

What you need You need the following to install the ODBC database drivers on the Workstation:

- ▶ Workstation ODBC Drivers installation CD
- ▶ Workstation ODBC Drivers serial number

Procedure Use this procedure to install the optional ODBC database drivers on the Workstation.

Step	Action
1	Close all programs running on your computer.
2	Insert the Workstation ODBC Drivers installation CD into the CD-ROM drive of the Windows computer. (Continued on next page)

(Contd) Step	Action
3	<p>Did the installation program start automatically and display the Welcome dialog box?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ If YES, GO TO Step 5. ▶ If NO, continue to next step.
4	<p>Select Run from the Start menu. In the Run dialog box, enter the following command where <drive> represents the letter assigned to the CD-ROM drive, then click OK.</p> <p>Example <drive>:\setup</p> <p>System Response Setup displays the Welcome dialog box.</p>
5	<p>Click Next to continue.</p> <p>System Response Setup displays the Gentran:Server 6.1 License agreement dialog box.</p>
6	<p>Click Yes to accept the license agreement and continue installation of the ODBC database drivers.</p> <p>System Response Setup displays the Registration dialog box.</p>
7	<p>Enter your name, company, and the Workstation ODBC Drivers serial number. Click Next.</p> <p>Note You must complete all three fields to continue with the installation of the ODBC database drivers.</p> <p>System Response Setup displays the Choose Destination Location dialog box.</p>
8	<p>Is the directory displayed in Destination Folder the directory in which Gentran:Server Workstation was installed?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ If YES, GO TO Step 10. ▶ If NO, continue with the next step. <p style="text-align: right;">(Continued on next page)</p>

(Contd) Step	Action
9	<p>Click Browse and select the directory in which Gentran:Server Workstation was installed, and click OK.</p> <p>Note You <i>must</i> specify the same Destination Folder for the ODBC Drivers as the one in which Gentran:Server Workstation was installed.</p>
10	<p>Click Next.</p> <p>System Response Setup displays the Check Setup Information dialog.</p>
11	<p>Are the displayed current settings correct?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ If YES, click Next to continue. ▶ If NO, click Back until you find the dialog you must change. Make your changes, then click Next until you return to the Check Setup Information dialog box. Click Next to continue. <p>System Response Setup displays progress information as it installs the software. When finished, it displays the Setup Complete dialog.</p>
12	<p>Do you want to let Setup restart the computer now?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ If YES, click Yes and remove any disks from the disk drive. ▶ If NO, click No.
13	<p>Click Finish to complete setup.</p>
