Visual Mapper - Workstation

Overview

If you have maps created with version 5.1-1, 5.2, 5.2-1, or 5.3 of Gentran:Server, you can install the current version of the earlier mapper — the Visual Mapper— to facilitate the transition to the new mapper — the Application Integration Mapper. Installing the Visual Mapper is optional.

These instructions explain how to install the Visual Mapper for Gentran:Server Workstation 6.1. They are a supplement to the *Gentran:Server Workstation Getting Started Guide*. Please refer to that guide for system requirements and all other installation information for Gentran:Server Workstation 6.1.

Installing the Visual Mapper on the Workstation

Introduction

To install the Visual Mapper, you run the Windows program setup.exe from the Workstation Visual Mapper installation CD.

Before you begin

You must first install the core Gentran:Server Workstation software before you can install the Visual Mapper. See "How to Install Gentran:Server Workstation" in the Gentran:Server Workstation Getting Started Guide.

What you need

You need the following to install the Visual Mapper on the Workstation:

- Visual Mapper installation CD
- Visual Mapper serial number

Procedure

Use this procedure to install the Visual Mapper on the Workstation.

Step	Action
1	Close all programs running on your computer.
2	Insert the Workstation Visual Mapper installation CD into the CD-ROM drive of the Windows computer.

(Contd) Step	Action
3	Did the installation program start automatically and display the Welcome dialog box?
	▶ If YES, GO TO Step 5.
	■ If NO, continue to next step.
4	Select Run from the Start menu. In the Run dialog box, enter the following command where <drive> represents the letter assigned to the CD-ROM drive, then click OK.</drive>
	Example <drive>:\setup</drive>
	System Response Setup displays the Welcome dialog box.
5	Click Next to continue.
	System Response Setup displays the Gentran:Server Visual Mapper License agreement dialog box.
6	Click Yes to accept the license agreement and continue installation.
	System Response Setup displays the Registration dialog box.
7	Enter your name, company, and the Workstation Visual Mapper serial number. Click Next .
	Note You must complete all three fields to continue with installation of the Visual Mapper.
	System Response Setup displays the Choose Destination Location dialog box.
8	Is the directory displayed in Destination Folder the directory in which Gentran:Server Workstation was installed?
	▶ If YES, GO TO Step 10.
	If NO, continue to the next step.

9	Click Browse and select the directory in which Gentran:Server Workstation was installed, and click OK .
	Note You must specify the same Destination Folder for the Visual Mapper as the one in which Gentran:Server Workstation was installed.
10	Click Next.
	System Response Setup displays the Setup Type dialog box.
11	Do you want to select which components of the product to install? (We recommend this for advanced users only.)
	■ If YES, select Custom Installation and click Next. Continue to the next step.
	Note Before you select the components you want to install, contact Customer Support for assistance.
	If NO, select Full Installation. GO TO Step 15.
12	Select the components you want to install from the list in the Select Components dialog box. (Check to include a component; clear to omit it.) Click Next .
	Note Click the Disk Space button to check for available disk space on other drives.
13	Did you select to install the Standards Files?
	▶ If YES, click Next and continue to the next step.
	▶ If NO, GO TO Step 15.
14	Select the standards you want to install from the Standards Installation dialog box. You can select individual standards or use the Select all button to choose all the standards.
	System Response Setup displays the Setup Type dialog box.
	Note Latest Standards are the most recent standards provided by Sterling Commerce.

15	Click Next.
	System Response Setup displays the Check Setup Information dialog box.
16	Are the displayed current settings correct?
	▶ If YES, click Next to continue.
	■ If NO, click Back until you find the dialog box you must change. Make your changes, then click Next until you return to the Check Setup Information dialog box. Click Next to continue.
	System Response Setup displays progress information as it installs the software. When finished, it displays the Setup Complete dialog box.
17	Do you want to let Setup restart the computer now?
	▶ If YES, click Yes and remove any disks from the disk drive.
	If NO, click No .
18	Click Finish to complete setup.
