## 1.3 Documents Introduced in Release 8.5

In Release 8.5, a new document, *Sterling Warehouse Management System: Voxware Integration Guide*, has been created.

## 1.4 Voice-Based Picking

Voice-based picking in the Sterling Warehouse Management System enables pickers to interact with the system using voice communication with handsfree mobile units. As a mode of communication, voice is easier to understand, and allows pickers to perform their operations more efficiently with both hands. To enable voice-based picking, the Sterling Warehouse Management System has been integrated with Voxware's VoiceLogistics Pro™.

## 1.5 Multiple Schema Support

Sterling Warehouse Management System, Release 8.5, supports multischema deployment. Multiple enterprises can be deployed across multiple schemas and database instances.

Sterling Warehouse Management System: Business Intelligence also supports multischema mode, providing new data sources that are based on the schema types.

## Known Issues

---

This chapter describes the known issues that you may encounter in Release 8.5 of the Sterling Warehouse Management System.

Some of the defects listed in this chapter will be addressed in future 8.5 maintenance pack releases. To determine if a defect has been addressed in a maintenance pack, review the *Hot Fix Release Notes* that accompany the maintenance pack.

### 2.1 Sterling Warehouse Management System Issues

This section lists the known issues in the Sterling Warehouse Management System.

- **140836** - The creation of views provided by Sterling Warehouse Management System: Business Intelligence Framework fails if Sterling Warehouse Management System is installed on a database having different schema name and user name.

**Solution/Workaround:** None. This defect will be addressed in a future maintenance pack release of Sterling Warehouse Management System Release 8.5.

- **141394** - When performing slotting, the moves suggested by third-party software are not always optimized because sometimes when the move should directly be between the source location and the target location in the active zone, it suggests a move from the source location to a location in the bulk zone, and then to the target location.

**Solution/Workaround:** None.

- **141419** - When creating pack and hold putaway tasks for a load pallet, if the load pallet has containers for multiple shipments, the system creates a move request with duplicate move request lines. A putaway task is created for one of the lines and the duplicate lines fail with exceptions upon releasing the move request.  
**Solution/Workaround:** None.
- **141593** - When performing slotting, multiple tasks from the same source location to the same target location and pertaining to the same item are not getting consolidated.  
**Solution/Workaround:** None.
- **141771** -When performing slotting, tasks are not completed if the location has inventory with LPN.  
**Solution/Workaround:** Do not track LPNs in the active zone.
- **141800** - When performing slotting, some tasks are created in "HELD" status even though these tasks are not dependent on other tasks.  
**Solution/Workaround:** None.
- **141810** - When confirming the shipments that are included in the load, one copy each of shipment and load BOL gets printed. However, three copies are supposed to be printed.  
**Solution/Workaround:** None.
- **142013** -When performing slotting from the "Apply Slotting Suggestions" panel, if the number of locations are approximately 2000 and the number of items are approximately 15000, the time taken for optimizing the slotting is approximately two and a half hours.  
**Solution/Workaround:** None.
- **142259** - When performing slotting or recalculating item velocity codes, the value of the `yfs.VelocityCode.AnalysisLevel` property is not being considered.  
**Solution/Workaround:** None.
- **142325** - When performing slotting, the system does not consider the case volume.

**Solution/Workaround:** None.

- **142417** - When a user wants to perform slotting and selects Inventory > Recalculate Item Velocity Code and enters the time period considering only the current year, but the actual period falls in the current month of the current year, the forecasted data is not considered as that month.

**Solution/Workaround:** None.

- **142418** -When performing slotting, Enterprise dedications at the Zone level in a node are not considered for slotting because no solution is provided by the third-party company that supports it.

**Solution/Workaround:** None.

- **142419** -When performing slotting, the maximum number of locations for each SKU is not considered when more than one active zone is considered for slotting.

**Solution/Workaround:** Ensure that you have only one active zone.

- **142450** - When performing slotting, Storage Codes of the active zones are not considered for slotting because no solution is provided by the third-party company that supports it.

**Solution/Workaround:** None.

- **142461** - When performing slotting, only the Mix SKU and Mix Product Class Constraints in the active zone are considered.

**Solution/Workaround:** Except for Mix SKU and Mix Product Class constraints, remove all other Mix constraints.

- **142470** - When performing slotting, wrong tasks are created when locations have inventory with an LPN in the active zone that is being considered for slotting.

**Solution/Workaround:** Do not track LPNs in the active zone.

- **142545** - When performing slotting, if there is a task that has to be executed to deposit an item to a location, and if that location has been dedicated for another item, the user cannot deposit the item.

**Solution/Workaround:** None.

- **142546** - When performing slotting, move tasks are not created if there is pending quantity for any location in the active zone that is considered for slotting.

**Solution/Workaround:** Do not have pend out quantity for any location in the active zone that is considered for slotting.

- **178937** - If the first task in an assignment is skipped, Voxware's VoiceLogistics Pro does not send information about the skipped task to the Sterling Warehouse Management System during the pick request. Because of this, the Sterling Warehouse Management System returns tasks from the same location.

This issue occurs only if the first task in an assignment is skipped.

**Solution/Workaround:** Perform a short pick, that is, pick zero quantity instead of skipping the first task in an assignment.

- **178938** - When an assignment is completed, Voxware's VoiceLogistics Pro sends an asynchronous notification message to complete the task in the Sterling Warehouse Management System. If this message is lost, Voxware's VoiceLogistics Pro does not send this message again to the Sterling Warehouse Management System.

**Solution/Workaround:** Complete the tasks manually in the Sterling Warehouse Management System using the Task Console screen.

- **180041, 180904** - If either the Voxware's VoiceLogistics Pro server or the voice unit fails, Voxware's VoiceLogistics Pro recovers from the exact voice prompt at which it failed, and the user can continue picking from this voice prompt. However, this recovery may fail intermittently.

**Solution/Workaround:** Either log off the affected user from the voice unit using the Vox Console, or restart the Voxware's VoiceLogistics Pro server. If the issue still remains unsolved, please contact Sterling Customer Support.

- **180235** - Voxware's VoiceLogistics Pro does not allow reuse of a container (case or pallet) that was previously used for picking.

**Solution/Workaround:** Purge the completed assignments regularly to recover the used containers.

- **182443** - If multiple users perform picking from the same source inventory case or pallet, the application does not prompt the last user to pick the entire case or pallet even if the quantity remaining in the case or pallet is equal to the quantity that is to be picked by the last user.

**Solution/Workaround:** None.

- **194884** - A hyperlink to the next page is displayed in the Order Shipment Report even if the report contains only one page.

**Solution/Workaround:** None.

- **194891** - The values of the label on the vertical axis of the "Containers by Carriers" bar chart in the In-progress Container Summary Report are displayed improperly.

**Solution/Workaround:** None.

- **198241** - The bar graph in the In-Progress Container Summary Report does not display the values corresponding to the displayed records.

**Solution/Workaround:** Perform the following steps to rectify the display of the bar graph:

1. Open Report Studio.
  2. Open the Container\_dashboard\_report.xml file.
  3. Navigate to the Query Explorer, and select the AllShipmentContainers Query.
  4. Set the Use Local Cache property to NO in the left hand property panel.
  5. Save the report.
  6. Repeat steps 4 to 6 for all the other queries.
- **198438** - When a location count is performed by counting a pallet in a different location, the Physical Inventory Count Detail Report displays an incorrect value of the item quantity in the System Quantity field.
- Solution/Workaround:** None.
- **198601** - When the serial number of a serial-tracked item is changed during the execution of the count task, the Physical Inventory Count Detail Report displays incorrect values in the System Quantity field and the Count Quantity field.
- Solution/Workaround:** None.
- **198881** - Context-sensitive help is not available for the following screens:

- Print Case/Pallet LPN Label (under the Inbound menu option)
- Print Case/Pallet LPN Label (under the Inventory menu option)

**Solution/Workaround:** None.

- **198892** - The sections under the *Sterling Warehouse Management System: Voxware Integration Guide* are not in synch with the local documentation library.

**Solution/Workaround:** None.

- **199026** - The application does not refresh the Container Volume Monthly Report with the correct data after a shipment has been shipped.

**Solution/Workaround:** Run the Container Volume Monthly Report again to view the new data.

- **199055** - In the Billing Activity Report, if billing activity is recorded with multiple currencies, the Total value is displayed incorrectly and the currency shown against it is always USD.

**Solution/Workaround:** None.

- **199244** - Context-sensitive help is not available for the Print SKU Labels Search screen and the corresponding Item List screen.

**Solution/Workaround:** None.

- **199460** - The Parcel Manifest Report takes a long time to display data.

**Solution/Workaround:** Run the report when less activities are taking place in the warehouse so that the load on the system is less.

- **199461** - The Replenishment Status Report takes a long time to display data.

**Solution/Workaround:** Run the report when less activities are taking place in the warehouse so that the load on the system is less.

- **199468** - The Dedicated Locations Activity Report takes a long time to display data.

**Solution/Workaround:** Run the report when less activities are taking place in the warehouse so that the load on the system is less.

- **199470** - The Containers not having Standard Quantity Report takes a long time to display data when an enterprise code is entered in the search criteria.

**Solution/Workaround:** Run the report when less activities are taking place in the warehouse so that the load on the system is less.

- **199479** - The In-Progress Container Summary Report takes a long time to display data.

**Solution/Workaround:** Run the report when less activities are taking place in the warehouse so that the load on the system is less.

- **199482** - The In-Progress Shipment Summary Report takes a long time to display data.

**Solution/Workaround:** Run the report when less activities are taking place in the warehouse so that the load on the system is less.

- **199484** - The Receipt Detail report takes a long time to display data.

**Solution/Workaround:** Run the report when there are less activities in the warehouse so that the load on the system is less.

11. Verify whether the selected options are correct, and click Next.
12. Save and run once.

13. Click Finish.
14. After import, ensure that the public folder contains the WMS-Analytics package.
15. Run the `ant -f ynwinstallanalytics.xml -l deployPackageWithReports.log` script to deploy the report.
