5.1 Dispatcher.pdf

The dispatcher is WSM's caching and load balancing tool.

Use the search engine tools if you encounter problems with WSM's internal search engine, or if you run into performance issues and suspect that WSM's search engine causes them.

5.3 ProxyServer.pdf

This tool is a proxy server that relates requests from one port of your computer to another port, and displays all the requests it relates. Use it to find out exactly which information is passed between WSM and a Web browser.

5.4 ThreadDump.pdf

This tool allows you to see which Java threads are currently active. This can help you locate the cause of a non-specific problem, such as an overall slowdown or unresponsiveness.
