About the Release Notes for Fixpak 11 updates to DB2 Universal Database for z/OS, XML Extender Version and 8

This document contains information about the DB2 Universal Database for z/OS XML Extender, Version 8, supplementing information in DB2 Universal Database for z/OS XML Extender Administration and Programming, Version 8. The information in these release notes includes all topics except installation.

Chapter 1. Migrating XML Extender from previous releases

You do not need to migrate from DB2 fixpak 10 (PTF UK07289).

If you have been using DB2 XML Extender Version 7 or an earlier Version 8 release, you must migrate each DB2 subsystem enabled for DB2 XML Extender before using them with this PTF. To migrate the subsystem, customize and run the following two jobs in the SDXXJCL data set. Instructions for customizing the jobs are in the JCL prologue for each job.

DXXRBIND

This job rebinds all the DB2 packages and plans. You must run this job if you already enabled the subsystem.

DXXMIGRA

This job drops, creates, and alters functions and stored procedures.

Failing to do the migration step can cause the DXXADM disable_server option and the dxxGenXMLCLOB and dxxRetrieveXMLCLOB stored procedures to fail.

Chapter 2. What's new in XML Extender with Fixpak 11?

The following updates in Fixpack 11 are available on DB2 for z/OS: XML Extender in PTF UK12148.

- IY75262: Data is no longer decomposed into multiple rows when it should be decomposed into one row.
- **IY75456:** There is no longer a length limit for the <condition> statement of an <RDB_node> associated with an <element_node>.
