Target Group

Aim

- The course communicates in a very compact form R/3 administration and installation on DB2 UDB for experienced, certified "SAP R/3 Technical Consultants". It also includes a practical R/3 Installation on DB2 UDB on a Windows NT server.

- certified "SAP R/3 Technical Consultants", e.g. UNIX/ORACLE, NT/SQL Server

2. Test: DB2 UDB Database Administration

2.1 Overview

Certification candidates applying for on "DB2 on UNIX and Windows NT" oriented certification must successfully complete the R/3 - DB2 Common Server Database Administrator test together with the respective R/3- Operating System Interface test and the R/3 Basis System test.

The DB2 on UNIX and Windows NT test currently applies towards the SAP R/3 Technical Consultant certification for the following R/3 System variants:

- R/3 Release 3.0, UNIX, DB2 UDB
- R/3 Release 3.0, NT, DB2 UDB

The goal of the DB2 UDB Database Administration test is to establish whether a test participant has a good understanding of the R/3 System interface to this database platform.

The test includes covers DB2 Universal database Version 5, although DB2 Common Server V2 is also covered as a subset.

Certification candidates can prepare themselves for the Database Administration tests by attending the respective R/3 Database Administration course (BC500 series), database manufacturer's training, and through supplementary practical experience as well as BC317.

The test consists of approximately 40 multiple-choice taken from the following topics:

2.2 R/3- DB2 UDB Database Administration test topics

- **Database Architecture in the R/3 Environment**
 - Be familiar with and understand the R/3 System interface to DB2 on UNIX and Windows NT
 - Be familiar with DB2 instances in the R/3 Environment
 - Be familiar with database processes and files
 - Understand the logging mechanism
 - Understand the tablespace and container architecture
 - Be familiar with DB2 configuration aspects in the R/3 environment
 - Be familiar with the R/3 naming conventions for database files
 - Be familiar with database startup and shutdown procedures
 - Schedule database administration tasks
 - Be familiar with R/3 and database users and user authorizations
 - Be familiar with networked database environments

- **Database Maintenance and Administration**
 - Be familiar with R/3 System database administration tasks
 - Be familiar with and understand the meaning of database and operating system parameters and logs
 - Use SAP database monitoring tools
 - Perform daily administrative tasks using the database Alert Monitor
 - Perform administrative tasks using the DB2 command line processor , the DB2 database director, and the DB2 Control Center
 - Monitor database freespace situations
 - Monitor database backups
 - Monitor database performance
 - Be familiar with basic aspects of database tuning
 - Be familiar with database index monitoring
 - Be familiar with update statistics and verify
 - Use and understand database freespace checks
 - Restore a database so it may be used to install another R/3 System
 - Understand R/3 System security aspects

- **Database Backup Strategy**
 - Be familiar with database backup tools
 - Be familiar with backup types
 - Use database tools to plan and implement backup strategies
 - Use the CCMS for backup maintenance
 - Schedule backup execution and monitor backups

- **Database Backup Media Management**
 - Use database tools for tape initialization
 - Understand tape management and selection
 - Be familiar with the tape formats used for backups

- **Database Restore and Recovery**
 - Understand and be familiar with database recovery types, mechanisms, phases, and consequences
 - Run a restore of database backups
 - Recover a database

- **Storage Management Administration**
 - Be familiar with disk space requirements
 - Be familiar with tablespace and container administration
 - Understand storage space and volume management
 - Verify that the setup of filesystems, directories, and devices comply with SAP data security and performance standards
 - Be familiar with SAP naming conventions for containers
 - Understand database fragmentation
 - Schedule and understand database storage monitoring
 - Analyze, plan, and schedule database reorganization

- **Recognizing and resolving problem situations**
 - Be familiar with typical recovery cases and steps necessary to reimport data
 - Be familiar with the location, contents, and analysis of diagnostic files
 - Identify and respond to a log full or database full condition without loss of data
 - Handle table space overflows
 - Handle disk crashes
 - Resolve database performance problems
 - Resolve brarching errors
 - Resolve table/index problems
 - Resolve situations where DB2 cannot offload the online retained log files.
 - Restore the database after the loss of a tablespace
 - Restore the database using a offline backup
 - Restore the database using a online backup
