Health check

Discovering improvement opportunities

Concentrating on the core extract, transform and load (ETL) development and operational environments, the Health Check workshop provides onsite discussion and analysis of data warehouse or data integration projects with key members of client project teams. It includes analysis of IBM[®] WebSphere[®] DataStage[®] (formerly WebSphere DataStage Enterprise Edition) jobs for:

- Design review
- Performance and tuning recommendations
- Recommendations on advanced techniques
- WebSphere DataStage project and version control review
- Change management in development, test and production environments
- Scheduling and managing WebSphere DataStage jobs in a production environment

Laying the foundation for success

 Provide guidance and recommendations related to environmental and job-level architectures to support the overall solution




Figure 1. Services offerings within the software development life cycle




Figure 2. Services workshops for the WebSphere DataStage parallel framework
