U. S. Coast Guard Readiness

Management System

The U. S. Coast Guard Readiness Management System (RMS) required a system that would make the exact state of readiness of all its units instantly available across the entire organization.

This system had to support up to 35,000 users, with 1,000 concurrent users; and it had to be usable by field personnel with little computer training.

Initially, the Readiness Task Force deployed Cognos to consolidate information from existing databases, then output it immediately to a service-wide, secure, Web-based readiness management and reporting system.

The system tracks six key facets of Readiness: personnel, training, equipment, supply, infrastructure, and information. Its dashboard uses the familiar red-yellow-green color codes for rapid problem recognition. A mouse click gives the user access to the detailed information needed for rapid, intelligent resolutions.

Readiness information is accurate and always available. Overall organizational performance has measurably improved, as has mission effectiveness.

In 2002, the Coast Guard upgraded its Cognos applications to take advantage of new reporting and display capabilities offered by Cognos Series 7.

United States Marine Corps Finance

The U.S. Marine Corps needed a solution that would enable sharing of activity-based costing (ABC) data across the organization for comparative analysis.

The Marines had 20 sites using ABC models, but could only look at one model at a time, and could not therefore do any comparative analysis. Consolidating the 20 models into a single database, made the information available, but it was unwieldy, difficult to access, and required specialized training to use.

Using Cognos, the Marines put the data into a data cube, then made it available over the Web so that sharing or moving files was no longer an issue. Some 200 users, who required almost no training, have full (restricted as authorized) access to the information.

Cognos has made all ABC data instantly available at all 20 sites, where costing specialists now accurately track 37 processes in transportation, utilities, training and operations, support, and simulations. With a global view at their fingertips, they can compare costs at different locations, drilling down right to the expense type to find root causes for discrepancies and anomalies: data quality, differences due to local conditions, inefficiencies—and efficiencies—and take corrective action where required.

The Cognos project yielded such positive results that the costing department shared its experience with general accounting, which is now considering adopting the solution for the entire Marine Corps' general ledger.

NASA: HR data that works

NASA manages approximately 20,000 civil service employees in a number of locations around the U.S. Managers require up-to-date information on payroll, hires, separations, promotions, reassignments, awards, etc., and must compile regular workforce reports.

NASA's workforce data is used for analysis purposes, to look at trends in the workforce, and to make comparisons between duty centers.

With Cognos, NASA is able to easily update, on a quarterly basis, dozens of graphic workforce reports that appear on their Web site. For example, if a manager wants to know the age distribution of professional staff at NASA (both professional administration as well as S&E) or the occupational distribution (clerical, technical, professional, S&E, and so on), they can obtain this information quickly and easily.

Not only do users get the right information at the right time, but now a human resources staff of three instead of eight can handle requests, with a one-day turnaround time instead of a month. This frees staff up for other duties.

NASA has deployed Cognos to give its employees and the public direct access to human resources information through the Internet. Users of the NASA HR Web site can view statistical information as well as their own files, and use advanced reporting and analysis capabilities.

Users can answer their own questions rather than requesting special reports. And they can do it in a fraction of the time it used to take.

Previously, NASA published an annual workforce report that covered a wide range of employee details, such as hires and losses, diversity profiles, education levels, salaries, and employment opportunities. Now, the report is published quarterly and takes a day or less to prepare. The result is the data users receive is up-to-date and still useful.

Thanks to the Cognos security model, the maximum amount of information is made available but confidential files remain protected and accessible only to those with permission to see them.
