

How to change the chart's title

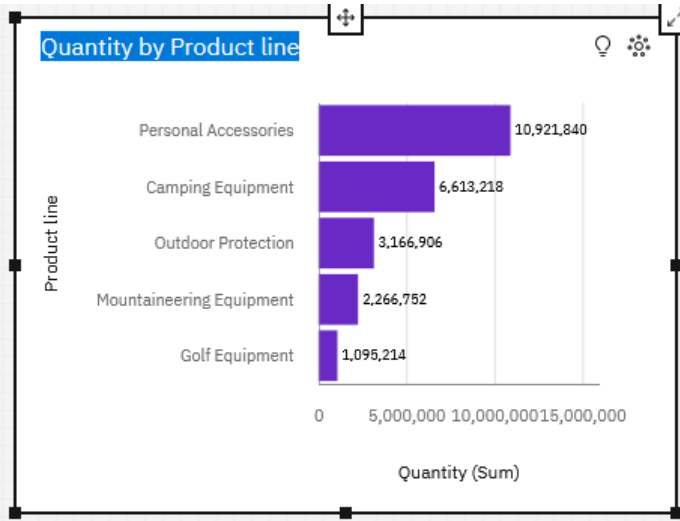
Suppose you have created a bar chart like this:



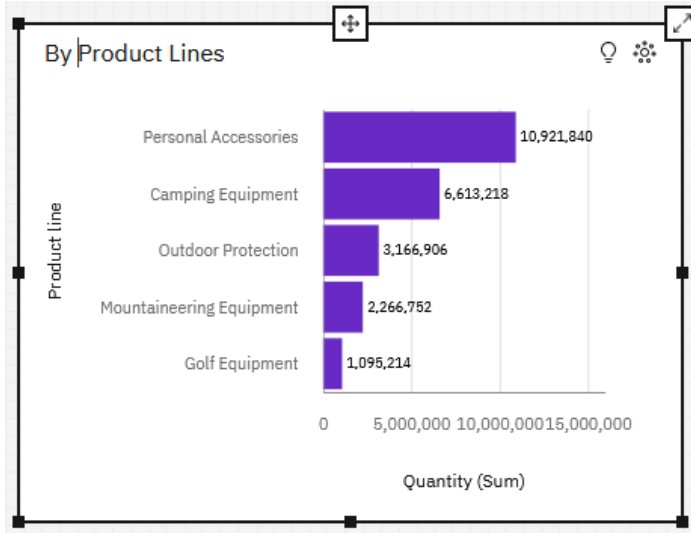
Now you would like to change the default title at the top of the chart. This chapter will show you how to do that...

Modify title

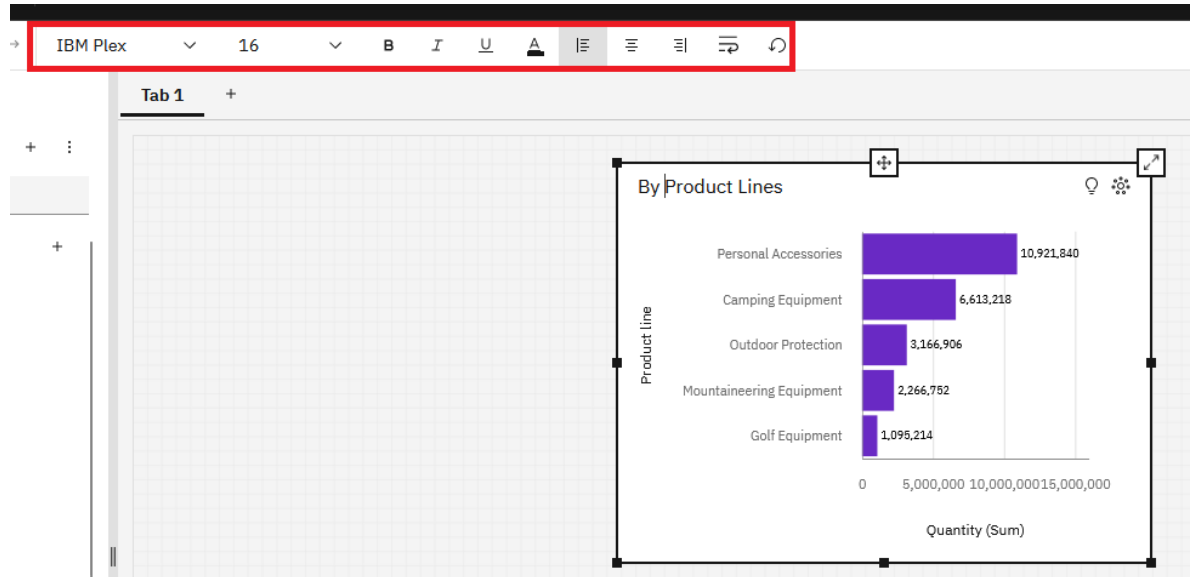
1. Start with the bar chart you recently created (see [How do I add value labels to the bars?](#)).
2. Double-click the title to select it:



3. Type a new title:



4. Notice that while your cursor is within the title, the context toolbar changes to offer you text tools:



This is a good time to change the font, bold your title, change the color, etc. However, for consistency, **all** your chart titles should have the same attributes.



Technical

Now that you have changed the title, the *Title type* property for the visualization has changed to *Custom title*. It is no longer what we call a *Smart title*.

Title type

You can also set this property to *No title* if you would rather let the Axis titles speak for themselves and save the space/keep it simple.
