
A Note about Icons (Images) in Sample Extensions

Many of the sample extensions (e.g. SampleExtensionOpenDashboard_11_2.zip) use hard-coded icons that are light in color (e.g. #f4f4f4):

These samples have been optimized for Cognos Analytics' 11.2.0 default theme (IBM Carbon X), which employs the following background colors:

- App Bar: #161616
- Hamburger Menu: #161616



These are only samples, or *examples*. In the sample extensions, the SVG icons that you will find in the images folder are all light (e.g. #f4f4f4). This light color works perfectly with the dark background of Cognos Analytics' default theme:
