# The Data Explosion

## An eDiscovery Challenge

Information volume doubles every

**18–24 months**



Up to 90 percent of the world's information was created in the last two years.

## eDiscovery – Costs



The average eDiscovery inquiry involves over **560,000 documents**. This volume of data demands over **11,000 manual review hours** at a cost of **\$771,000**.

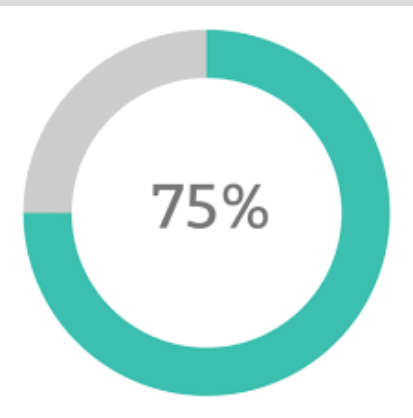

## eDiscovery – Risk – Errors



Manual, error-prone processes make it extremely difficult to find all relevant data and produce chain-of-custody documentation.

75% of surveyed businesses implement information governance to mitigate risk.

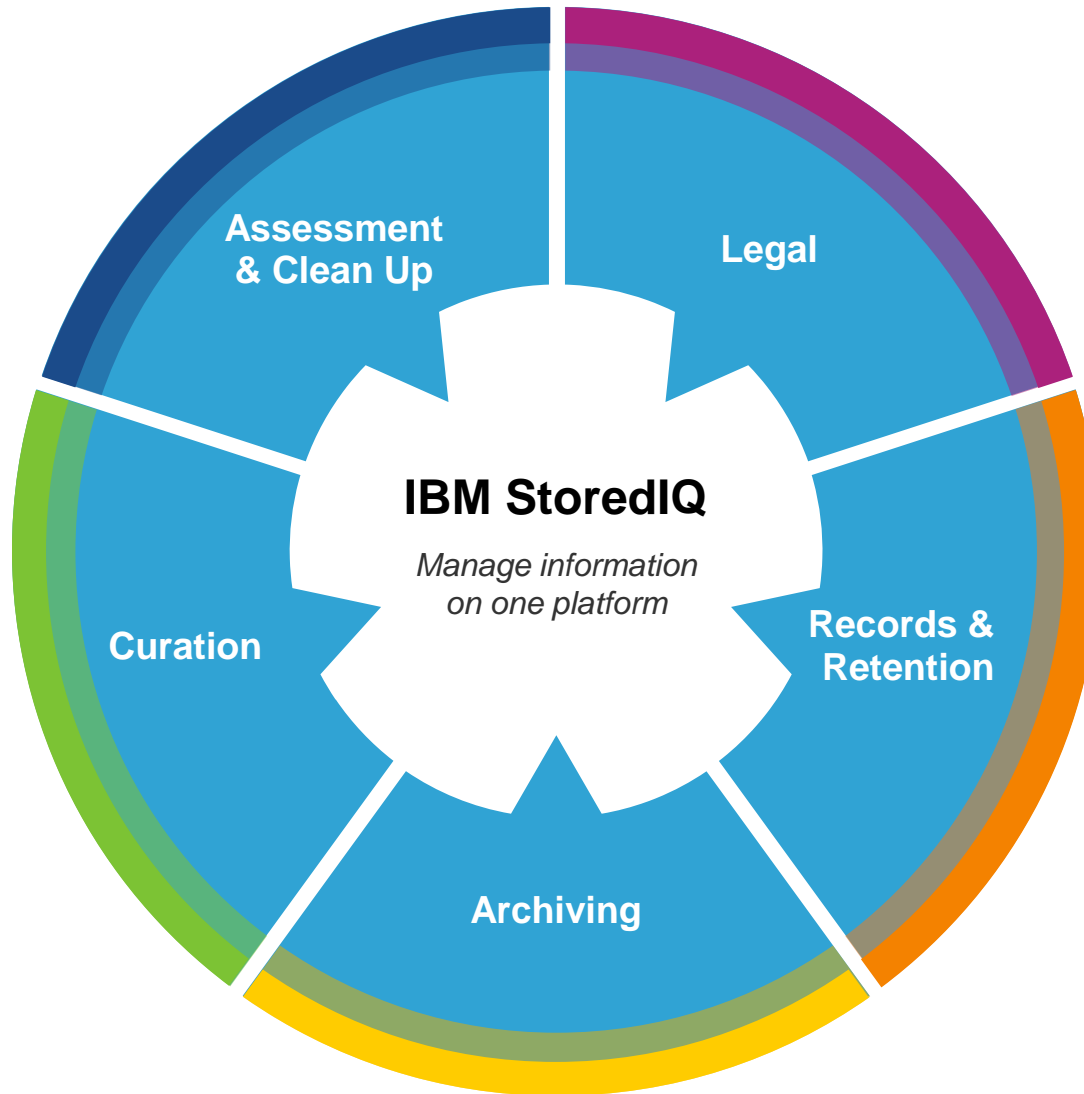

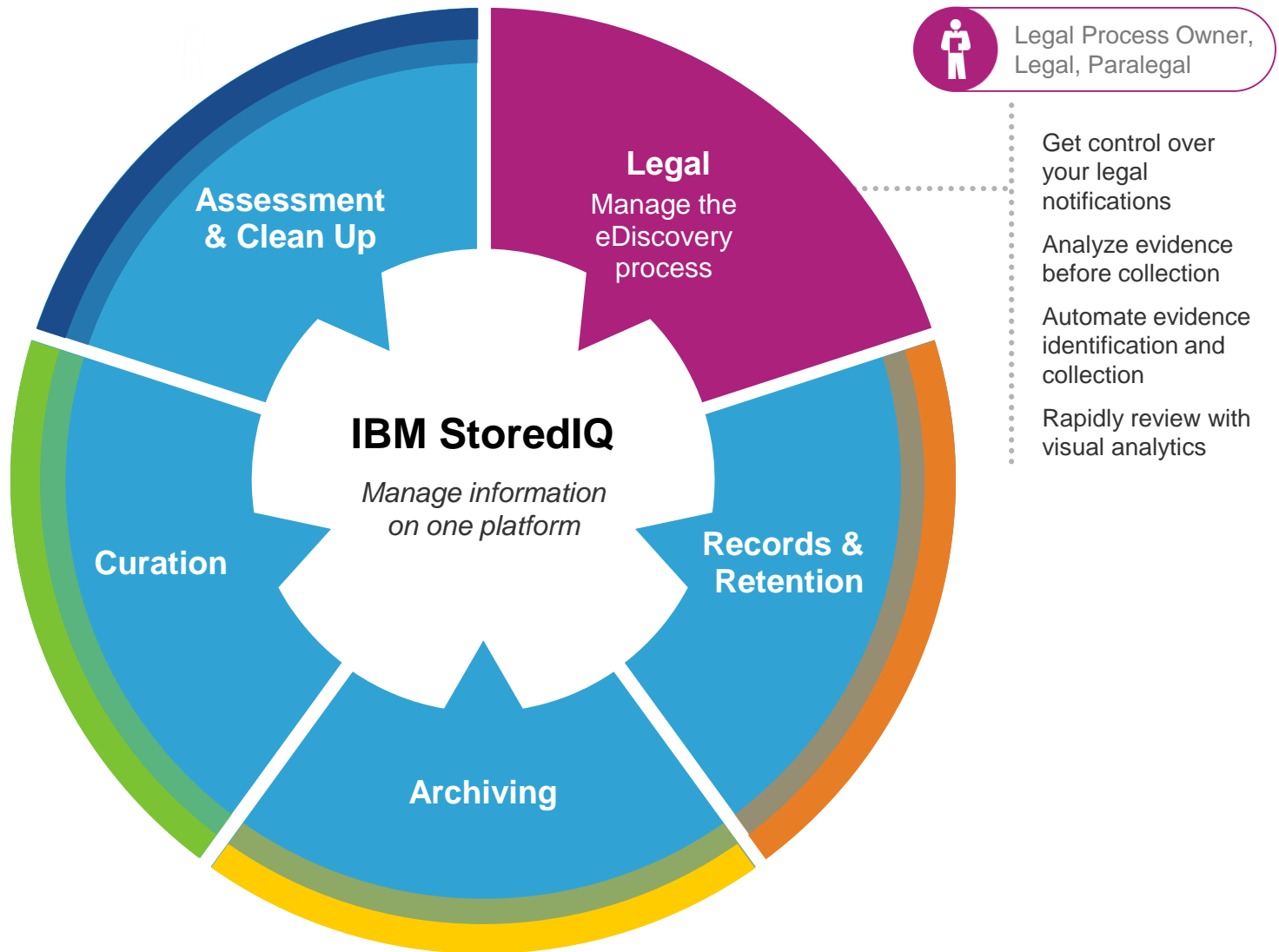

Supported largest litigation case in the world by identifying, collecting analyzing & classifying 132 TB of data to produce 200GB of relevant data



StoredIQ

**PROBLEM:** For *The Deep Water Horizon* matter, look across 132TB's, 3 continents and 8 locations. Collect 1TB to a preservation location in Houston. Full text indexing and apply additional terms to reduce to the smallest defensible data set which was sent out for production review by outside counsel. Final data set was approximately 200 GB's.

**SOLUTION:** Enable a 100:1 reduction in collection process in less than 2 weeks.

**ROI:** Saved million of dollars, responded to every DOJ request; substantially lowered outsourced review costs and built a defensible audit trail.
