Exposing Services to Users

- Bring services together based on the task at hand
- A big myth is that a "Service" (a unit of business activity) needs to be automated to be part of an SOA
 - In fact, most business services actually involve humans in their execution
 - And many business services are actually collaborations between a number of people
 - Humans use various IT services in the execution of tasks
- Portals expose services to users in meaningful ways
 - Compose services into tasks driven by users
 - Create sections of your portal targeted at specific tasks

Pre-built Extensions enable companies to quickly create composite portlets and applications that leverage data and processes from multiple backend systems via SOA.


















Advanced Personalization






