RAVEN Enhancement

- IC72264 Adds the ability to activate multiple copies of the same RAVEN automation variation.
 - Without option only 1 process and STARTUP_TASKS are rerun on successive activations.
 - ? In the AUTO ACT syntax allows for a 2nd process to be started.
 - Useful when multiple automation processes (variations) needed with the same logic.
 - TAPE processing




New 'Auto ACT' syntax for multiple process

- AUTO ACT <variation name>?<optional postfix> <optional parameters>
- ? Informs RAVEN to create a new REXX process with a unique variation name.
- <optional postfix>
 - When not specified <variation name>?yymmdd_hhmmssxxx
 - Auto var output uses this format to identify variation.
 - Date/time activated with xxx as milliseconds
 - Or specify your own naming convention with postfix.

New syntax for FILTERTEST utility

- IC77119 In order to utilize the same filter rule engine as the filterrule management function.
- Format
 - frm -t *filename*
- -t runs a filter rule syntax test and displays any errors in a list on the command prompt. If specified, you must also specify a file name.
- Without –t option filterrule management GUI invoked
- **Filename** specifies the filter rule file that you want to view or change. If a file name is not specified, you can load a file from the File menu of the console window.

Command Line Filter Rule Test

samplefile.dat

- -N Auto -T auto -NEW "05auto &1 &2 &3 &4 &5 &6 &7 &8 &9" -O COMMAND -s 1
- -N CONSMSG -T AAE* FG yellow
- -N AUTOMSG -T AAES0009I -FG pink
- -N LOG2FILE -T log2file -NEW "`02log2file &1 &2 &3 &4 &5 &6 &7 &8 &9 -O COMMAND
- -N FILTCMD -T DSYS00011 -FG peach -GL "!cmd notepad"
- -N CONTITLE -T DSID0001I -K "THE SYSTEM ID" -GENLOCAL "!title &6 &7

results of checking samplefile.dat (frm –t samplefile.dat)

- [5] Invalid color for -FG argument
- [6] Invalid -GENLOCAL argument(missing closing ")
- **** Syntax error check completed. You have 2 error(s). ****

Note: FRM samplefile.dat will continue to bring up Filter Rule Management GUI

- IC75958 Filter rules with many WAV files can cause hang
- IC76945 On Windows 7 may get errors on deletion of held messages
- IC78104 Latest JRE updates for JAVA 1.5 SR 10

 - Unzip package and run TOSAPAR.BAT to apply.
- Patch file containing all the latest closed APARs
 - TOS_PATCH_V1206_20111014.ZIP
 - Extract and run tospatch.bat
 - tospatch.bat corrects issue with patch install on Windows 7 and Server 2008.
