- Migration Assistance (Debugger and Toolkit)

- TPF Operation Server (TOS)
  - Ability to activate multiple copies of the same automation script



## z/TPF Database Facility Update - Now available

#### Performance

- Reduce unnecessary allocation and initialization of storage
- Provide more granular controls to minimize resource contention
- Reduce time required to initialize databases

#### Capability

- Provide support for updated SDO specifications (2.1)
- Expand allowable range of file addresses in B+Trees files
- Provide easier C/C++ application access to sort workfiles

#### Operational Enhancements

- Enhanced data collection statistics
- Improve usability of z/TPFDF online maintenance commands
