

## **5.1 May, 2001 PTF Pak - 010551**

**28 May 2001**

### **To All ICMS Technical Support Personnel:**

This document contains a summary of the PTFs that are being shipped for ICMS Release 5.1 in the PTF Pak, May-01 (010551). The Pak has been tested in a customer test environment to ensure that you are receiving a quality product.

This PTF Pak has been compiled from a number of separate PTFs. These were developed as fixes to problems that have been identified from customers, and projects

**Please note PTFs should be installed into the library ICMSPTF. If you have installed an individual PTF, received after the previous 5.1 PTF Pak has been installed, then you must determine whether or not it, and/or any of its pre-requisites, need to be reapplied after you have installed this Pak.**

### **Fix Distribution Process**

The Fix distribution process for PTFs and PTF Paks is as follows.

- Problem reported by a Geography L2 on behalf of a customer.
- Problem resolved, tested and inspected.
- PTF sent to the reporting Geography L2 together with information on any pre-requisite PTFs
- The Geography L2 sends the PTF to the customer. Any changes for customer specific objects must be made prior to the PTF installation.
- The PTF Pak is built from all PTFs developed after the previous PTF Pak, tested and sent to all Geography L2s.
- The Geography L2 sends the PTF Pak to customers. Any changes for customer specific objects must be made prior to the PTF installation.

## 5.1 May-01 PTF Pak Contents

The Pak is made up of the following individual PTFs developed from 14 February 2001 to 8 May 2001.

This 5.1 PTF Pak includes, in addition to a number of individual PTFs, some 'Sysroute' PTFs (a 'resync' of an error from a lower release of ICMS), as a result of an initiative undertaken to speed up the fixing of errors, found at lower releases, in 5.1. To assist in this individual items were grouped together by object, so that in some cases a number of items were 'Sysrouted' into 5.1 under one of them. These are included with the individual PTFs in the table below. PTFs in this Pak that are a result of 'Sysroute' activity can be identified by the term 'Sysroute' in the Description

## **New Function / Enhancements**

The following APARs do not introduce completely new function but extend the existing function. It is for that reason they are mentioned here.

### ***APAR # SC33722 (Distn # 401929)- Write off Purge does not print a report***

The Write Off Purge (BL2120) has been enhanced to produce a report displaying the entire contents of the purge file prior to the file being deleted.

### ***APAR # SC33537 (Distn # 401832) - In S/O Scroll, unable to stage Service Orders to stage code 99***

The S/O Scroll has been modified so that when a user enters a numeric value less than 100 against a S/O, the following rules are followed in processing that entry.

- 1) If value is between 30 to 36 then call linecard screen
- 2) Otherwise validate value against MSXREF00 Access Code = 'SOMAINTS' + Service Code. If no record found, try again for Access Code = 'SOMAINTS' + S/O Classification + Service Code.
- 3) If no record exists in MSXREF00 then entered value is deemed to be a stage code.
- 4) If record exists in MSXREF00 then entered value is deemed to be a valid option.

### ***APAR # SC33209 - (Distn # 401141) - Call Collection cannot process AMA records with new Modules attached***

This PTF allows the user to define those Modules attached to AMA records that are to be ignored by the Call Collection process. Two new files, and an associated file maintenance function, are introduced containing all the Ignore Module codes for Call Collection processing. If the Module Code is in these files then it will be ignored for Call Collection processing.

### ***APAR # SC33485 (Distn # 004307) - Pilot Number Validation Modification***

In the base ICMS Release 5.1, Pilot Number validation is mandatory against the Pilot Number file (PLPILT00). Users have to set up Pilot Number Groups in the file PLPILT00 before they can assign Pilot Numbers within provisioning. There is no other option.

This PTF to 5.1 was developed to allow Pilot Number Validation to be mandatory or optional at a system level. A new system process flag, VALIDPILOT, was added to SYPRCX00 to control whether or not the Pilot Number validation is enabled / disabled.

1. If VALIDPILOT is set to 'Y', then Pilot Numbers will be validated against Pilot Number file, (PLPILT00).

2. If VALIDPILOT set to 'N', then Pilot Numbers will not be validated against Pilot Number file, (PLPILT00).

VALIDPILOT will be defaulted to 'Y' when created.

***APAR # SC33356 (Distn # 004298) - TAP 3 Enhancements to reference field maintenance and conditional population process***

**Out Collect File Conditional Single Field Population**

Three new fields are added to population rule parameter file. These three fields are:

1. conditional flag,
2. presence/absence flag and
3. reference field.

The population rule maintenance program is changed to allow maintenance of these new fields.

The population program is changed to utilise the new fields:

1. Conditional flag to determine whether generic conditional population is required.
2. If generic population is required, the data content in the reference field is retrieved from the out collect record.
3. Based on the result of data retrieved from the reference field and the presence/absence field, the population program will decide whether the population rule is to be executed or to be bypassed.

**Enhancement to Out Collect Conversion Error Report**

A new 'Out Collect Conversion Error List' (CL1750FP1) is introduced to the Out Collection process that prints more details than the current report generated by the Out Collect process. The new report includes details from the Out Collect Call Detail file (CLOUCL00) which are listed in the Pre-Install Instruction section of the Implementation Instruction document in savefile I151010551.

***APAR # SC33568 (Distn # 004284) - Allow Wildcard Search on LATA Code***

LATA code is an attribute used in the rating of North American calls and is defined to the Rate Table Names Maintenance parameter within ICMS. This field allows a single (3-numeric) value to be entered or selected from those LATA codes valid to ICMS.

LATA indicator is an attribute used to determine whether the call was an intra LATA or inter LATA call and is also used in the rating process.

The Rate Table Names Maintenance program was modified to allow a wildcard value in the LATA code field. The V&H Rater module was also modified to cater for the wildcard search.

A wild card entry is allowed when other specifically defined entries exist. Similarly specific entries are capable of being entered irrespective of a wild card entry.

Generic wildcarding is **not** provided e.g. LATA code **46\***, or **4\*6**, or **\*60**.



***APAR # SC33567 (Distn # 004283) - Addition of Access Number to Billable Call File***

The Billing Telephone Number (EMRSKY) field has been added to the Billable Usage Template file (BLDFMT00) and all the programs which refer to BLDFMT00 were recompiled.

In ICMS 4.0 the Toll files were altered and the field EMRSKY (Billing Telephone Number - BTN) was dropped for disk storage reasons.

However this information is required to support the archive of call data, where the ICMS internal service number will lose relevance should call data be reviewed some years later. It is a US statutory requirement that this information be made available.

***APAR # SC33566 (Distn # 004282) - AMA Ticket Conversion File Changes***

With LNP changes for originating/terminating LRN modules, the length of the AMA record sometimes exceeds 200 positions.

The existing AMA Call Collection input file TB000000 and Revalidated Error file CCTBRV00 were increased from 200 to 400 bytes to accommodate the LRN modules. The DMS Error Detail file CCDMER00 was also modified, increasing the field CDDATA from 200 to 400 bytes.

## Installation Instructions

For full details on how to install a PTF Pak please refer to the '*ICMS PTF Application Guide*', a copy of which can be obtained from your Geography L2.

**Note:** Some of the ICMS PTF Installation Objects in library ICMSPSUP were changed for 5.1. Please ensure that you are using the latest versions that were sent with the initial release of 5.1. In addition to that please check that the data area CHGCTLDTA and the command APYICMSPTF exist only in library ICMSPSUP. Any other versions must be deleted.
