



This IBM Education Assistant module demonstrates adding users and groups to Tivoli Netcool/Proviso 4.4.3 DataMart.

The Netcool/Proviso administrator can use the **Users Configuration** tool to control access to Netcool/Proviso DataMart tools.


With the **Users Configuration** tool the Netcool/Proviso administrator can control:

Which users can launch the DataMart tools

Which users have read-only access to the DataMart tools


Which users have full access to the DataMart tools

Specific groups of users need access to some but not all of the DataMart GUI tool modules. You can construct groups to permit access to the modules that a group needs and to restrict access to the modules that a group does not need.




After you run the **Users Configuration** tool, you can add, modify, or delete access to the DataMart tools for groups and users. In this example, you are adding a user.

Two users currently exist by default, the root user and the user created at installation. In this example, the name of the user is **pvuser**. Click the add icon to add a user.




A user must have a system login on the DataMart server before you can add that user to the DataMart. In this example you see a list of UNIX® users in the drop-down menu of the **New User** window.




After you select the user to add from the menu, type a description for the user in the **Full name** field. Make sure the group to which you are adding the user exists before you add the user to that group.

Select a group to associate with the user. A user can belong to multiple groups, but that decision can affect the permissions available to the user.

In the example you are adding the user to the **reports** group. This group was created for Netcool/Proviso report developers on this installation. The group exists, but you have not granted the user permissions to access DataMart tools.



After you add the user to the group, click **OK**.




You can add or modify groups. For example, to modify the **reports** group, open the **Groups** tab and highlight the **reports** group. Click the edit icon to modify the group.



You can also edit the **Group name**, **Description**, user membership, and group permissions. Click **Permissions**.




You can assign read and write permissions to the group for individual DataMart tool modules. You base these permissions on the needs of the group. When you assign read permission, the users can use the module to view information but not to modify information. When you assign write permission, the users of the group can use all of the functions associated with the module. When you assign the write permission you automatically assign the read permission.




Use the scroll bar to assign permissions to the individual modules. Notice that no permissions are granted for the **Database Information** module.


After you assign permissions for the group click **OK**.



To view the permissions assigned to the user, highlight the user name and click the edit icon.




The user has read permission for the **Users Configuration** module.




When the DataMart GUI tool runs, the user can only see the modules for which you granted the user permission. In this example you did not grant read or write permissions to the Database Information module.


When the user opens the Monitor tab, the **Database Information** icon shows the module to be unavailable. In addition, if the user attempts to launch the module directly, an alert message is displayed telling the user that permission to run the module is unavailable.



When you specify read-only permissions for a module, the user can open the module. In this example the user has read permissions for the **Users Configuration** module.



If the user has read-only permissions on the **User Configuration Tool**, the user cannot access the add icon or the edit icon.
