This presentation will describe the steps to activate the licenses for the Rational Developer for Power Systems Software product on your machine.


## Client License Activation

- Rational Developer for Power Systems Software includes four separately licensed features:
  - RPG and COBOL Development Tools for i
  - C and C++ Development Tools for AIX
  - C and C++ Development Tools for Linux
  - COBOL Development Tools for AIX
- Passport Advantage clients can purchase authorized user or floating user licenses for the four features.
  - Activation kits are downloaded from the Rational License Key Center
- IBM i clients who use eConfig/AAS can purchase authorized user licenses.
  - Activation kits can be downloaded from Entitled Software Support (ESS) site or receive the activation kit CD with the physical product media
- By default, a 60-day trial license for each installed licensed feature is enabled when you first install the product.
  - Uninstalling and reinstalling does not reset 60-day period

The product has 4 separately licensed features. You can purchase licenses for any of the 4 features. In Passport Advantage, authorized user and floating user licenses are available. IBM i client who use eConfig/AAS can purchase authorized user licenses. By default, a 60-day trial license for each installed feature is enabled when you first install the product.

## Install Sequence – activate license (1 of 4)

- Use 'Manage Licenses' in IBM Installation Manager to install your authorized user license or configure floating licenses.

IBM Installation Manager is used to activate the feature licenses. You can use the Manage Licenses wizard to specify the information to activate a license.

## Install Sequence – activate license (2 of 4)

- Within the product, a 'Manage Licenses' toolbar button is shown you have any trial licenses




- ▶ Also, a dialog opens when the product starts if you any trial licenses



The product provides a Manage Licenses toolbar button if you have trial licenses. Also, a dialog is shown when the product starts if you have trial licenses which has a Manage Licenses button.

## Install Sequence – activate license (3 of 4)


- After clicking on Manage licenses from within product, you can select Apply License
  - ▶ This will start Installation Manager's Manage Licenses wizard



The Manage License dialog from within the product shows you the status of the product licenses. The Apply License button will start Installation Manager's Manage Licenses wizard.

## Install Sequence – activate license (4 of 4)

- In Installation Manager, select the feature you want to activate and then select Import Product Activation Kit (for authorized user) or Configure Floating license support (for floating user)



In Installation Manager's Manage Licenses wizard, you can select the feature you want to activate and then select either Import Product Activation Kit for an authorized user license or Configure Floating license support for a floating user license.

## Install Sequence – activate floating user license (1 of 6)

- To activate a floating user license, select Configure Floating license support
  - ▶ Using RPG and COBOL Development Tools for i as an example, other features are similar










- Refreshing License Status in Manage Licenses in product shows the updated status











## Install Sequence – expired licenses

- If you install some of the licensed features but do not activate all of them, the features which are not activated will expire after the 60-day trial.
- Expired features will need to be removed.
- In Installation Manager, select Modify to remove features without uninstalling the product
