

This presentation will show you how to install Sterling Connect Direct for Microsoft<sup>®</sup> Windows<sup>®</sup> version 4.7. You will initialize an IBM CMS Keystore for Secure Plus as part of the installation.



To install Sterling Connect:Direct<sup>®</sup> for Windows, you first need to download the installation .exe file. Next, you will start the application installer. When you see the installation shield wizard that is shown on the slide, click next to continue.



On the Setup Type panel, you can choose either a typical or a custom setup. The recommended option is Custom. Select Custom to choose which product features you want to install. You also will be able to choose where to install the features. Click next to continue.

From the custom setup panel, select the features that you want to install. If you are not using Solid DB for your database, you can change the database by clicking the icon in the list. Click "Next" to continue.



You will see a panel to configure the server. The recommended configuration option is custom. Select Custom, and then click "Next" to continue.

On the secure plus configuration options panel, enter the keystore file name and password that Secure plus must use to store the key certificates. You need to make a note of the password and keep it safe, as you are not able to access your keystore if you lose or forget it. Click "Next" to continue.

You will see a panel titled Service Account Information. If you want to run Sterling Connect Direct for Microsoft Windows under a user ID other than the installer, enter the details now, otherwise click Next to continue.

If you require SNMP Event logging, you can enable the agent and event logging on the panel titled SNMP and Event logging. Click Next to continue.

If you want to send email notifications, select SMTP, and enter your SMTP server connection details. Then, click Next to continue.
