

Title: IBM ILOG Elixir Installation

Welcome.

In this video, we'll see how to install the trial, import the samples and we'll also show the product installation--the one you get when you purchase--and the license activation to remove the watermark and to get access to the source code and then how to compile to get rid of the watermark.

So I execute the trial I just downloaded from the website.

I already have an Adobe Flex Builder Pro installed on my laptop, in the default folder. This provides you with important information such as "where is the component library SWC" that you need, SDK 3.2 and Flex Builder Pro 3.0.2?

Now, the installer suggests we have a look at the release notes, blog, and forum.

So that's the forum: the place to go to with any technical question, the release notes, as well as the blog (full of coding tricks and tips and samples)

Let's start Flex Builder.

I will import the samples: import other, general, existing projects into workspace, and then I would browse to C. Program Files. IBM. ILOG. Elixir 2.5. Samples.

You can see 11 of them.

So now their workspace is building, let's execute the first one.

It's working...watermarked...with a time limit.

Now I will skip the step of uninstalling the trial and I will proceed directly to installation of the product.

So this is another installer you will get once you purchase.

Same process.

Let's start again Flex Builder. Because I installed, I lost all of my samples.

Once again go to: C, Program Files, IBM, ILOG, Elixir 2.5, samples.

My workspace is building.

We're executing the calendar.

So, still a watermark, but a different one...with no time limits.

But to remove it we will use a tool which is installed with products and not with the trial which is named "The License Activator".

So I enter my license key . It recognizes that it's a valid one.

On activation , a new library SWC is generated without a watermark. And you also have a message about the OEM licenses: "Please check on the website"

Then I get access to the source code. We'll see in later videos how to dive from your code down to the library source code with a <control> click.

Let's come back to Flex Builder.

I need to clean all of my projects: so I click Project...Clean...Clean all projects. The workspace is rebuilding, and I will execute again the calendar.

As you can see, no more watermark.
