Based on IBM WebSphere Studio Workbench, WebSphere Studio family facilitates WebSphere Studio family integration. WebSphere Studio Workbench is available at no charge to commercial members of IBM PartnerWorld® for Developers. Based on the Eclipse project, this set of open-source tool integration frameworks, written in the Java™ programming language, can help developers integrate tools from many vendors to increase developer productivity. The Eclipse project is developed by an independent open source community, eclipse.org, run by industry leaders from the application development and operating system communities.



Ready for WebSphere Studio validation can allow you to broaden your marketing reach through use of the Ready for WebSphere Studio emblem and through several incremental marketing resources provided by IBM. Your customers can get application development tools that can integrate with the WebSphere Studio family and other application development tools, helping to maximize flexibility. Help your customers get to market faster by providing tools that are integrated with the WebSphere Studio Workbench or WebSphere Studio family of tools. Help simplify the skills required for evaluating and purchasing your tools. And help build customer confidence by providing offerings that have been validated to integrate with, and meet the standards of, the award-winning WebSphere Studio Workbench and WebSphere Studio family products.



Getting started

To qualify for participation, you must be a commercial member of IBM PartnerWorld for Developers. The Ready for WebSphere Studio program provides you with program requirements and tools to validate your software, according to two levels of predefined criteria:

- Ready for WebSphere Studio: IBM WebSphere Studio Workbench
- Ready for WebSphere Studio: IBM WebSphere Studio Family

To be validated as Ready for WebSphere Studio: WebSphere Studio Workbench, you must certify that your application development tools:

- Satisfy WebSphere Studio Workbench integration criteria at the user interface (UI) as well as at the application programming interface (API) or data level.
- Use WebSphere Studio Workbench APIs correctly.
- Follow all available UI guidelines.
- Operate successfully within the current WebSphere Studio Workbench environment.



To be validated as Ready for WebSphere Studio: WebSphere Studio family, you must certify that your application development tools:

- Satisfy the requirements for Ready for WebSphere Studio: WebSphere Studio Workbench.
- Meet WebSphere Studio family integration criteria, such as WebSphere Studio Workbench Java development tool APIs.
- When available, correctly use APIs in the WebSphere Studio family of products as specified in the program requirements.

Note: If your tools meet WebSphere Studio family API integration criteria, and you would like Ready for WebSphere Studio program validation, your product must be validated at the Ready for WebSphere Studio: WebSphere Studio family level.

Today, the WebSphere Studio family of products includes WebSphere Studio Workbench, IBM WebSphere Studio Site Developer and IBM WebSphere Studio Application Developer. Other WebSphere Studio products will be added as they become available. The integration criteria will cover use of WebSphere Studio Workbench facilities to:

- $\bullet \quad Launch \ your \ tools \ from \ Web Sphere \ Studio \ Workbench.$
- Create tool views within WebSphere Studio Workbench.
- Manage tool attributes and preferences.
- Connect tools to WebSphere Studio Workbench views and editors.
- Exchange data with and extend WebSphere Studio Workbench Java development tools.
- Exchange data with and extend WebSphere Studio product components.
- Create tool help information.
- Package and install tools.

Are you in?

Step through the validation process from the Ready for WebSphere Studio program Web site at **ibm.com**/partnerworld/developer/websphere/ready. Access the validation requirements, an application for the program and a pretest tool, which you can run on your product to verify that it is ready to be tested for validation. Based on the test results, a customized set of testing scenarios for the specific tool is sent to you for a full product testing. Once those product results are submitted and you certify that your product meets the defined requirements, IBM will determine whether your product qualifies for Ready for WebSphere Studio validation.
