It can help you share data effectively and reduce the cost of privacy compliance by automating manual procedures. Tivoli Privacy Manager for e-business can help you:

- Build trust by managing consent—Individual consent to privacy
 policies is recorded and then used by applications and business processes
 to respect customers' choices on how their data can be used.
- Integrate privacy policies into applications—A privacy editor digitizes
 privacy policies, which are then implemented in the applications and IT
 systems that need to comply.
- Track access to sensitive information through detailed reports—The reporting facility automatically generates detailed audit trails that show how your organization is respecting privacy choices.
- Integrate with identity management—Tivoli Privacy Manager for e-business is integrated with other key areas of identity management identity federation (cross-enterprise identity mapping and provisioning), identity lifecycle management (user self-care, enrollment and provisioning), identity control (access management) and identity foundation (directory and workflow). This provides consistent enforcement of privacy policies.

Tivoli Privacy Manager for e-business can help organizations fulfill all five steps of privacy management:

- **Define privacy policy**—Tivoli Privacy Manager Policy Editor can help you define new privacy policies and transform existing written policies into an electronic language (Platform for Privacy Preferences).
- Deploy privacy policy—Can deploy your privacy policies to specific
 applications and IT systems that use sensitive information. It works with
 existing applications to bind privacy policies to applications' use of
 sensitive information.
- Record user consent to policy—Can record end users' opt-in and optout choices according to your privacy policies, providing a centralized way to respect those choices when applications request access to sensitive information.
- Monitor and enforce access—Enforces access for approved business purposes according to your privacy policies.
- Create audit trail reports—Automatically generates detailed reports
 that show adherence to deployed privacy policies. Audit trail reports can
 show how an individual's data has been used by your organization.

Monitor Software Development Kit: A toolkit that helps you develop your own monitors
