- **Communicate using e-mail.** Send e-mails directly to a Place, or receive notifications about postings, updates, team calendar events and outstanding action items.

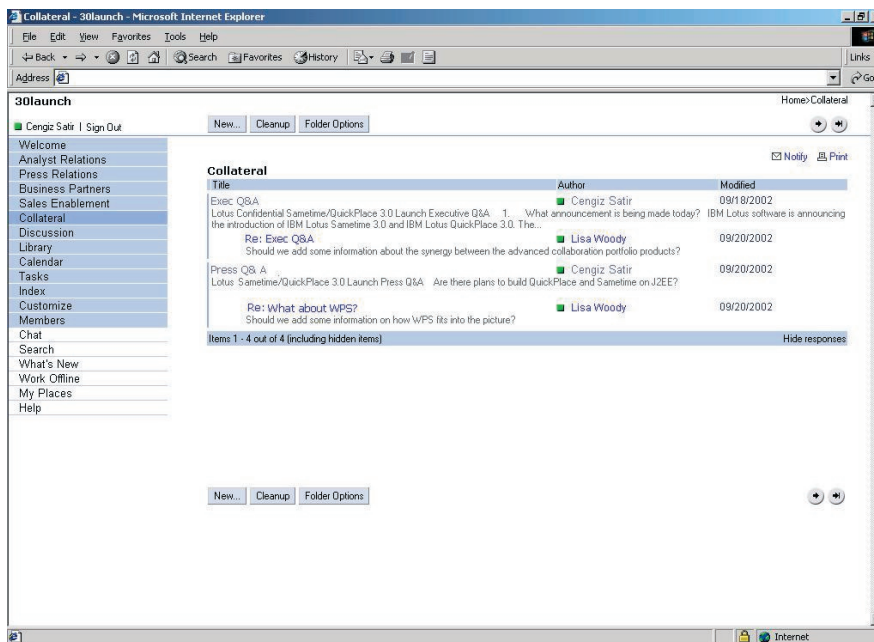

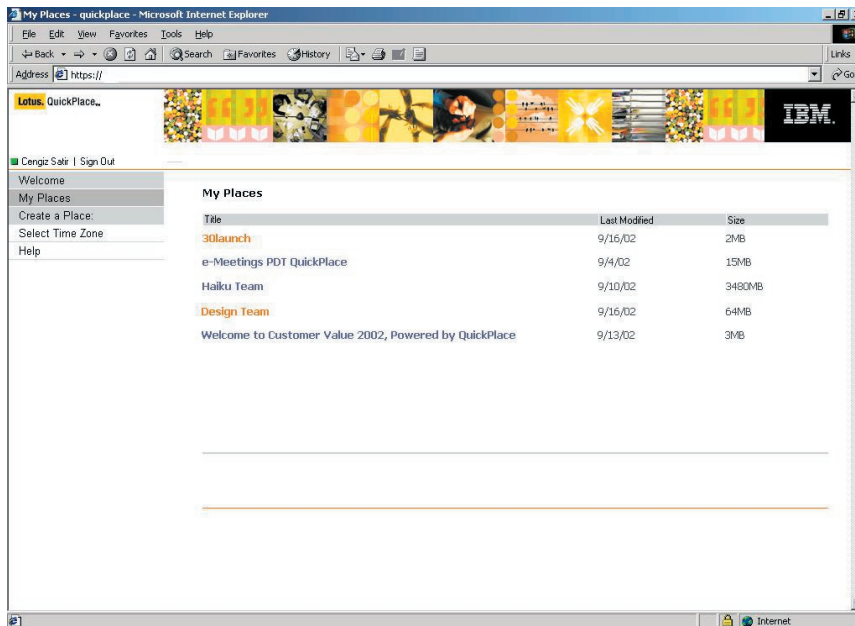
