

Overview of this Interim Fix:

This is the first cumulative Interim Fix for the OSGi Agent contained in WCTME EO 5.8.1. The ZIP file contains fixes for the following:

- 110992 - a fix for a failure that occurs when using DMS to distribute the OrderEntry bundle to a RedHat Linux WCTME-EO 5.8.1 client. The problem is timing related, and appears more readily on Linux, but is not limited to Linux, so the fix applies to other clients as well. The fix is contained in the following file:
 - **osgiprefpage.jar**
- 114121 – a fix for a problem that occurs when attempting to register a user name with DMS that contains single byte non-ASCII characters. This occurs with user names that contain single byte characters specific to non-English languages. The fix is contained in the following file:
 - **osgiagent.jar**
- 115189 – a fix for a problem that occurs when attempting to register a user name with DMS that contains double byte characters. This occurs with user names that contain characters specific to double byte languages such as Japanese. This fix is contained in the following file:
 - **osgiagent.jar**

Prerequisite products and versions:

You must have at least WCTME EO 5.8.1 installed before installing this Interim Fix. You may also install this Interim Fix if Interim Fix 001a for WCTME-EO 5.8.1 has been installed. This Interim Fix is cumulative and supersedes Interim Fix 001a for WCTME-EO 5.8.1. Do not install older Interim Fixes after installing this Interim Fix as you will replace newer files with older ones.

Instructions for installing this Interim Fix into WCTME EO 5.8.1:

1. Unzip the zip file into a directory on your WCTME EO workstation
2. If WCTME EO is running, close it.
3. Copy osgiprefpage.jar to <WCTME EO install dir>\eclipse\plugins\com.ibm.eswe.osgiagentextension_5.8.1.
4. Copy osgiagent.jar to <WCTME EO install dir>\eclipse\plugins\com.ibm.osg.service.osgiagent_1.5.1.3
5. Launch WCTME EO.
