Summary: if you use IBM Rational Rose Developer for Unix **your replacement product will be IBM Rational Software Architect Standard Edition.**

The replacement product is already available to you via Anticipatory Access and you may begin to adopt it at any time. You may also choose to migrate your IBM Rational Rose Developer for Unix entitlement to IBM Rational Software Architect Standard Edition but you will not be required to do so until the maintenance renewal part numbers for IBM Rational Rose Developer for Unix are withdrawn from Passport Advantage (for more information see our [Rose Expected Lifetime](#) .pdf document.)
