This document was last updated on September 9, 2008

Rose Enterprise is currently packaged as IBM Rational Rose Enterprise but it was formerly packaged as part of IBM Rational Rose XDE Developer Plus. The IBM Rational Rose Developer Plus offering contained the following

- 1. Rational Rose Enterprise
- 2. XDE Developer Plus, which in turn contained
  - XDE Developer for Java
  - XDE Developer for Visual Studio

The latest generation products that are the intended replacements for Rose and XDE are packaged as a number of more focused offerings. Thus the migration paths for Rose Enterprise are one-to-many. As an owner of Rose Enterprise you are entitled to all of the designated replacement offerings but may wish to choose only those that correspond to the subset of IBM Rational Rose XDE Developer Plus product capabilities that you have been utilizing.

The following table describes in general what your options are for proceeding through the migration process. Below the table you will find discussions on the recommended sets of replacement products based upon your historic usage of the Rose and XDE products.

## Owners of IBM Rational Rose Enterprise Who Use Rose Enterprise

(This guidance pertains to customers who have purchased IBM Rational Rose Enterprise as well as <u>former</u> owners of IBM Rational Rose XDE Developer Plus whose entitlements have been migrated to IBM Rational Rose Enterprise, and who use Rose Enterprise)

Summary: if you use Rose Enterprise as packaged in IBM Rational Rose Enterprise (which was formerly packaged in IBM Rational Rose XDE Developer Plus) your replacement products will depend upon which features of Rose Enterprise you use and which implementation technologies you target.

- 1. If you use Rose Enterprise only for modeling (no code generation) your replacement product will be IBM Rational Software Modeler
- 1. If you use Rose Enterprise for modeling and code generation in support of Java-based implementations and/or non-Microsoft C++-based implementations, your replacement products will be the combination of IBM Rational Software Architect Standard Edition and (optionally) IBM Rational PurifyPlus for Windows.

If you use Rose Enterprise for modeling and code generation in support of Microsoft language-based implementations, and look forward to using modeling in support of Microsoft .NET-based implementations, your replacement products will be the combination of IBM Rational Software Modeler plus IBM Rational Modeling Extension for Microsoft® .NET and (optionally) PurifyPlus for Windows. The combination of IBM Rational Software Modeler plus IBM Rational Modeling Extension for Microsoft® .NET is designed to be used in combination with Visual Studio. Studio (consult IBM Rational Modeling Extension for Microsoft® .NET product information on ibm.com product pages regarding currently supported versions of Visual Studio)

If you use Rose Enterprise for modeling and code generation in support of a heterogeneous mix of implementations that includes a mixture of Java-based and/or Microsoft .NET-based and/or non-Microsoft C++-based implementations, your replacement products will be the combination of IBM Rational Software Architect Standard Edition plus IBM Rational Modeling Extension for Microsoft® .NET and (optionally) IBM Rational PurifyPlus for Windows. The combination of IBM Rational Software Architect Standard Edition plus IBM Rational Modeling Extension for Microsoft® .NET is designed to be used in combination with Visual Studio. Studio (consult IBM Rational Modeling Extension for Microsoft® .NET product information on ibm.com product pages regarding currently supported versions of Visual Studio)

These replacement products are already available to you via Anticipatory Access and you may begin to adopt them at any time. You may also choose to migrate your Rose Enterprise entitlement to the replacement products but you will not be required to do so until the maintenance renewal part numbers for IBM Rational Rose Enterprise are withdrawn from Passport Advantage (for more information see our <u>Rose Expected Lifetime</u> .pdf document.)

## Owners of IBM Rational Rose Enterprise Who Use XDE Developer for Java

(This guidance pertains to <u>former</u> owners of IBM Rational Rose XDE Developer Plus whose entitlements have been migrated to IBM Rational Rose Enterprise, and who continue to use the XDE Developer for Java subset of XDE Developer Plus on an unsupported basis)

Summary: if you use XDE Developer for Java, as sub-packaged in XDE Developer Plus which was formerly packaged in IBM Rational Rose XDE Developer Plus, your replacement products will be IBM Rational Software Architect Standard Edition and (optionally) IBM Rational PurifyPlus for Windows.

These replacement products are already available to you via Anticipatory Access and you may begin to adopt them at any time. You may also choose to migrate your IBM Rational Rose Enterprise entitlement to IBM Rational Software Architect Standard Edition and (optionally) IBM Rational PurifyPlus for Windows, but you will not be required to do so until the maintenance renewal part numbers for IBM Rational Rose Enterprise are withdrawn from Passport Advantage (for more information see our Rose Expected Lifetime .pdf document.)

Also optionally, you could pay to trade IBM Rational Rose Enterprise or IBM Rational Software Architect Standard Edition to IBM Rational Software Architect for WebSphere Software.

## Owners of IBM Rational Rose Enterprise Who Use XDE Developer for Visual Studio

Summary: if you use XDE Developer for Visual Studio as sub-packaged in XDE Developer Plus which was formerly packaged in IBM Rational Rose XDE Developer Plus, **your replacement products will be Rational Software Modeler plus Rational Modeling Extension for Microsoft® .NET and (optionally) PurifyPlus for Windows**. The combination of IBM Rational Software Modeler plus IBM Rational Modeling Extension for Microsoft® .NET is designed to be used in combination with Visual Studio (consult <u>IBM Rational Modeling Extension for Microsoft® .NET product information on ibm.com product pages</u> regarding currently supported versions of Visual Studio).

These replacement products are already available to you via Anticipatory Access and you may begin to adopt them at any time. You may also choose to migrate your IBM Rational Rose Enterprise entitlement to the combination of IBM Rational Software Modeler, IBM Rational Modeling Extension for Microsoft® .NET and (optionally) IBM Rational PurifyPlus for Windows, but you will not be required to do so until the maintenance renewal part numbers for IBM Rational Rose Enterprise are withdrawn from Passport Advantage (for more information see our Rose Expected Lifetime .pdf document.)

Summary: if you use both XDE Developer for Java and XDE Developer for Visual Studio, as sub-packaged in XDE Developer Plus which was formerly packaged in IBM Rational Rose XDE Developer Plus, your replacement products will be Rational Software Architect Standard Edition plus Rational Modeling Extension for Microsoft® .NET and (optionally) PurifyPlus for Windows. The combination of IBM Rational Software Architect Standard Edition plus IBM Rational Modeling Extension for Microsoft® .NET is designed to be used in combination with Visual Studio. Studio (consult <a href="IBM Rational Modeling Extension for Microsoft®">IBM Rational Modeling Extension for Microsoft®</a> .NET product information on ibm.com product pages regarding currently supported versions of Visual Studio)

These replacement products are already available to you via Anticipatory Access and you may begin to adopt them at any time.
