Owners of Rose XDE Developer Plus Who Use Rose Enterprise

(This guidance also pertains to former owners of Rose XDE Developer Plus whose entitlements have already been converted to Rose Enterprise)

Summary: if you use Rose Enterprise your replacement products will be the combination of Rational Systems Developer or Rational Software Modeler, plus Rational Modeling Extension for Microsoft® .NET, plus PurifyPlus for Windows. As was the case with Rose Enterprise, you might apply these products across a number of different projects that target different implementation platforms and technologies such as Java, .NET, and ANSI C++.

In general, you would apply the replacement products as follows:

- Rational Systems Developer for Java and ANSI C++ projects
- Either Rational Systems Developer or Rational Software Modeler, plus Rational Modeling Extension for Microsoft® .NET, in combination with Visual Studio 2005 and .NET Framework 2.0 for .NET projects (in its latest generation of model driven development products, IBM Rational has elected to discontinue support for the older VB6 and "unmanaged" VC++ technologies.)

The replacement products are already available to you via Anticipatory Access and you may begin to adopt them at any time. You do not have to worry about migrating any of your Rose XDE Developer Plus or Rose Enterprise entitlements because over time, the entitlement issues will resolve themselves as part of the maintenance renewals process.
