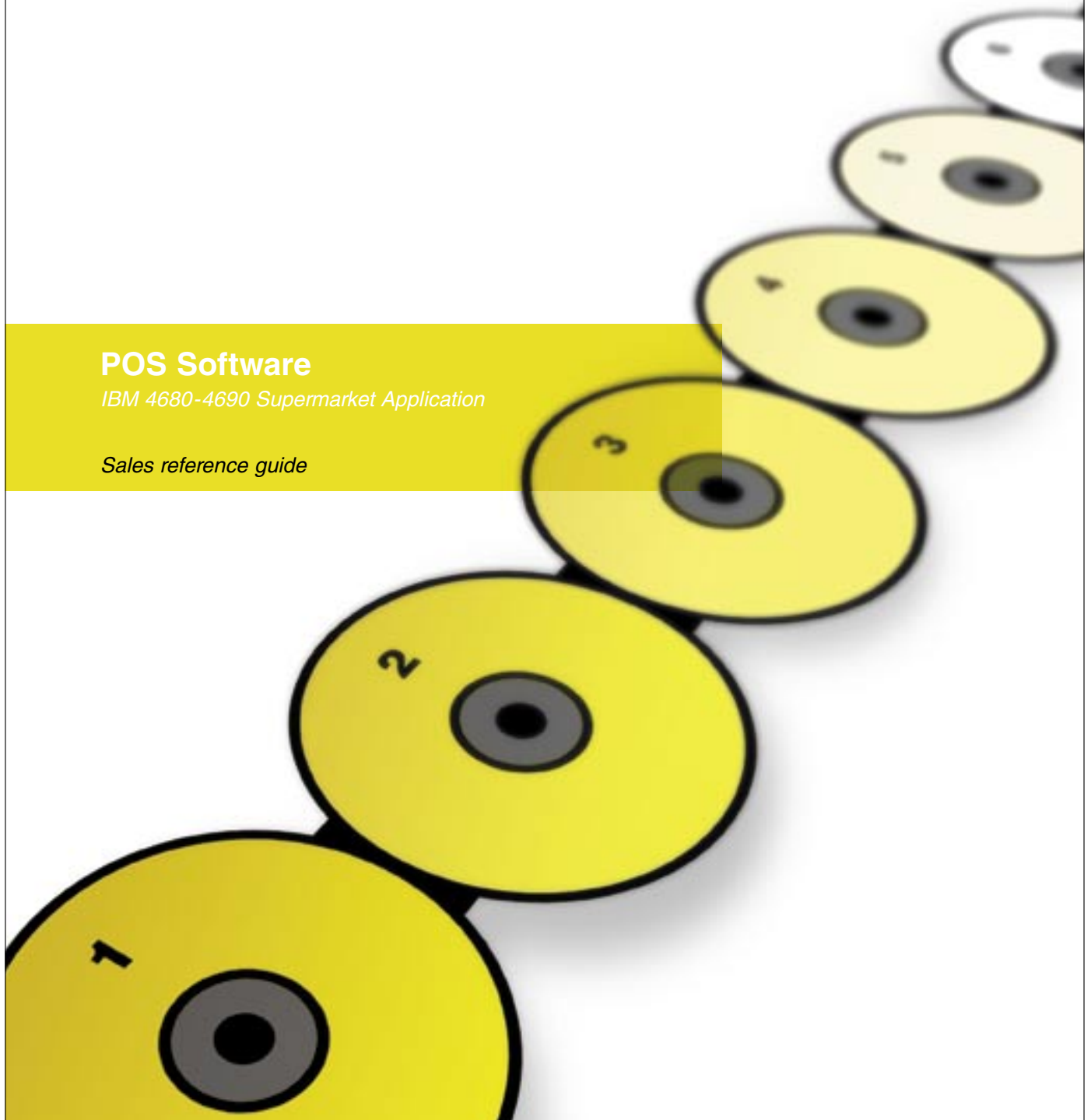

IBM 4680-4690 Supermarket Application

Sales reference guide



Summary

The IBM 4680-4690 Supermarket Application (SA) is a complete point-of-sale (POS) software offering designed to meet the needs of international and multinational supermarket and hypermarket retailers. It provides all the basic, supermarket-specific features and functions these retailers need for checkout support, reporting, data capture, accounting and inventory control, as well as advanced optional features retailers need to meet regional and store-specific needs. This software package gives retailers a single, powerful solution that can help increase efficiency at the POS, improve decision-making across the enterprise, and help operators deliver top-quality customer service in all stores worldwide. For many grocery retailers, using SA will be critical to realizing the retail on demand vision.

Key messages

1. IBM SA provides excellent investment protection

It runs on the IBM 4690 OS (one of the most reliable computing platforms in the industry) and Microsoft® Windows® 2000 (with Terminal Services). It supports most IBM 4683, 4693, 4694 and SurePOS™ 700 Series terminals. SA allows retailers to use a wide range of IBM and non-IBM peripherals. And it is available in multiple languages, so retailers can rollout the same software to stores around the world without creating customized versions to accommodate local language requirements.

2. IBM SA is powerful and versatile

SA processes up to 90,000 items per hour and performs subsecond price lookups for fast frontend operations. It comes standard with hundreds of checkout features, as well as mechanisms for reporting, data capture, accounting and inventory control. It handles all conventional payment options (cash, coupons, food stamps, debit, credit). Optional capabilities include electronic marketing support, touchscreen graphical user interface (GUI) support (via SureVision or ASTRA), electronic journaling, support for IBM SureMark™ Printers and enhanced Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT).

3. IBM SA is flexible

It can operate with or without a host. It offers flexible coupon processing, and pricing rules are applied automatically. Item records can also be linked. Store controllers can be programmed to make price changes on a specific day and time. Flexibility in the item file layout allows retailers to add fields for specific needs.

4. IBM SA offers advanced reporting and security

Reporting options include daily or weekly store cash, department analysis, item movement, terminal productivity and sales associate productivity, as well as other customized options. These reports provide the data retailers need to improve the speed of profitability of decision-making. Security features include encrypted password access and restricted access to refunds, paid outs and cash report retrieval. Setting entry and value limits, and validating voids and coupons are all simple, intuitive processes. A detailed audit trail is also available for up to 36 tender types.

5. IBM SA is a worldwide solution

Available in every geography, SA is a reliable choice for supermarket and hypermarket retailers who want to use the same software in all of their stores worldwide. Positioning

Portfolio comparison

IBM SA provides the same fast, reliable POS processing as IBM SurePOS ACE and IBM VisualStore, but it is targeted to the global enterprise. In other words, SA is the right software for retailers who operate in the Americas Group (AG), EMEA and AP, while those who operate only in AG should use SurePOS ACE, and those who operate only in EMEA should use VisualStore.

SA runs on the IBM 4690 OS. It offers a solid base package of capabilities, plus many optional features that allow retailers to create somewhat customized versions for their stores. It does not, however, support some of the more advanced capabilities of SurePOS ACE, such as self-checkout and fuel-sales integration.
