Enabling business continuity

IBM provides Business Recovery Centres to facilitate continuity of operations when an organisation is unable to carry out business from its usual premises. The centres are situated across the UK in locations convenient for major business conurbations. They are available to organisations subscribing to IBM Business Continuity and Resiliency Services.

Facility

MacAdam House is a two-storey facility that can provide upto 1000 work area recovery positions. Suites are equipped with the latest automatic call distribution (ACD) telephones, PC's, printers, fax machines, copiers and whiteboards. There are also meeting rooms providing full telephone and video conference facilities. Rest areas are fitted with simple kitchen facilities and vending machines.

The location is constantly accessible and in a state of readiness – 24 hours a day, 365 days per year.

Security

The building is accessed via a magnetic swipe card system and strict security processes are in operation. The access system can be tailored to meet the requirements of all clients, and individual suites or rooms can be isolated to provide additional security measures.

The site is monitored 24 hours a day, 7 days a week by digital CCTV and security officers. Intruder and sophisticated security alarms are installed throughout the location. In terms of smoke and fire detection, all datacentre/communications rooms are fitted with water and high temperature alarms, which are controlled by a single building management system that is constantly monitored.

Network

The facility can provide ISDN30, ISDN2, direct exchange lines, wide area networks (WAN), metrowave circuits and fibre carrier services.

Support

The facility is constantly supported by a team comprising technical communications experts and facilities management staff. This professional team is dedicated to supporting clients' business continuity solutions and requirements.

Location

Livingston Business Recovery Centre is ideally positioned to serve the needs of a wide range of companies in the region. The site is easily accessible from both Edinburgh and Glasgow via the M8. The closest rail link is Livingston South and Edinburgh Airport is 20 minutes drive.

Road

From Glasgow and Edinburgh take the M8 to Junction 3. Follow the A899 through Livingston to Lizzie Brice roundabout and take the third exit. Follow Bankton Road for approximately 2 miles. The industrial estate is the first exit off the roundabout. Take the first left again at the mini roundabout. Follow the road round to the right. McAdam House is the last entrance on your right.

Rail

Livingston South station is one mile away from the site. Alternatively, West Calder station is two miles away. Both are on the Edinburgh Haymarket to Glasgow Central line.

Air

Edinburgh airport is 12 miles from the site.

Bus

A regular bus service operates between Livingston and West Calder. The main road runs adjacent to the industrial estate and it takes around 5 minutes to walk to the site from the bus stop.
