IBM Disaster Recovery Services provides business recovery centres to facilitate continuity of operations in situations where an organisation is unable to carry on business from its own premises due to unforeseen circumstances. Business recovery centres are situated across the UK in locations convenient for major business conurbations. They are available for use by organisations that subscribe to IBM Disaster Recovery Services.

The Newcastle Business Recovery Centre

The Newcastle Business Recovery centre is located south of Newcastle, close to junction 63 of the A1, approximately 30 minutes from Newcastle Airport and 10 – 20 minutes from the Main Railway Line. The centre is ideally positioned to service the business continuity needs of all types of business located in the region.

Size and nature of facilities

The Newcastle Business Recovery Centre is a two-storey building comprising approximately 40,000 square feet of office space. The facility is managed and maintained by IBM Disaster Recovery Services, and is kept in a constant state of readiness 365 days a year. The centre is fully furnished and equipped with standard office facilities such as fax machines and photocopiers, with conference and meeting rooms. The Newcastle Business Recovery Centre has a capacity of up to 500 workstations, and is currently configured with 300 positions on the second floor, with three meeting rooms and one kitchen facility.

Security


The Newcastle Business Recovery Centre is covered by 24-hour security. The building is protected by CCTV both inside and outside. Where more than one organisation occupies the building, the security system is configured to ensure that each company has exclusive access to its own facilities.

The site is fully protected by fire detection systems. An emergency generator and uninterruptible power supply (UPS) system facilitate continuity of operations in the case of an interruption to mains electricity.

Travel directions overleaf



By car from the North

- Continue forward onto the Morpeth Bypass (signposted Newcastle A1)
- Continue forward onto the A1(M) (signposted The South, Durham)
- Leave the A1(M) at junction 63, then at roundabout take the fifth exit onto the A693 (signposted Stanley)
- At roundabout take the third exit onto the A693 (signposted Stanley)
- Turn right onto Drum Road, at roundabout take the first exit
- Continue along road, and arrive at Unit 5, Angel Park.

By car from the South

- Continue forward onto the A1(M) (signposted The North, Peterborough)
- At A1(M) junction 45 continue forward onto the A1 (signposted The North, Wetherby)
- Leave the A1(M) at junction 63 (signposted Stanley, Chester-le-Street), then at roundabout take the second exit onto the A693 (signposted Stanley)
- At roundabout take the third exit onto the A693 (signposted Stanley)
- Turn right onto Drum Road; at roundabout take the first exit
- Continue along road, and arrive at Unit 5, Angel Park.

By rail

Newcastle Railway station is 13 miles from the Newcastle Business Recovery Centre. Durham Railway station is 6 miles from the Centre, and Chester Le Street Railway station is 4 miles from the Centre.

By bus

Take bus number 725/726 or 733/734 from Newcastle to Birtley or Chester le Street

By Air

Newcastle Airport is 20 Miles from the Newcastle Business Recovery Centre.
