#### **Scorecard Primer**





#### **Scorecards Defined**

- Management system for gaining insight/perspective into actions/activities deemed most critical to achievement of strategic plan
- Can be driven by quantitative data (whether automated or manually capture) or qualitative data (in form of a questionnaire) or some combination of the two
- "Balanced Scorecard" vernacular introduced by Kaplan and Norton in '90s
- Scorecards are used for any number of purposes:
  - Monitor performance against objectives
  - Align activities with corporate/enterprise strategies
  - Provide commonality at point of evaluation
  - Consolidation of performance reporting



#### Why Scorecards?

- Business Scorecards allow collection and reporting of quantitative data in situations where:
  - Applications/systems are in place to collect data in an automated manner
  - Expectations of performance to be measured is known and agreed upon
  - Dedicated group in place to monitor and analyze metrics
- Business Scorecards allow collection and reporting of qualitative/subjective data in situations where:
  - Performance Management/measurement is just beginning
  - Agreement on appropriate measures haven't/can't be made
  - Qualitative data points are unattainable, cost prohibitive or undetermined
  - Desire to augment quantitative data with qualitative data



#### Scorecards Challenges

- Agreement on what to measure
- Agreement on the standards for measurement
- Ability to get automated, quantifiable data in cost effective manner
- Consolidation of KPIs into single report
- Making performance metrics and reports relevant to individual consumers




#### **Scorecard Creation and Updating**

- Scorecards are typically created with input from personnel around the organization
  - Program Managers
  - Project Managers
  - Business Unit Owners
  - "C Level"/ Executive Management Team (CIO, CFO, COO, etc.)



#### Scorecard Use Within the Project Lifecycle








#### Sample Questions by Lifecycle Phase



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


## Overview of Scorecards in RPM






#### WBS and Scope Scorecards in RPM
