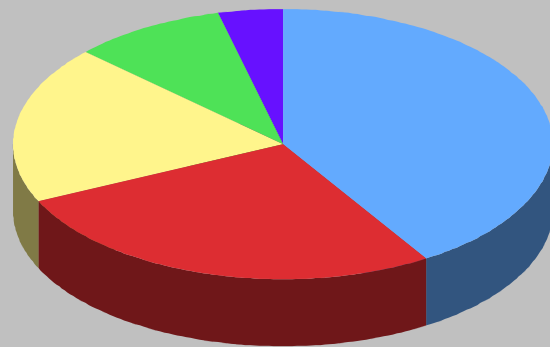

Line of business managers (27%)

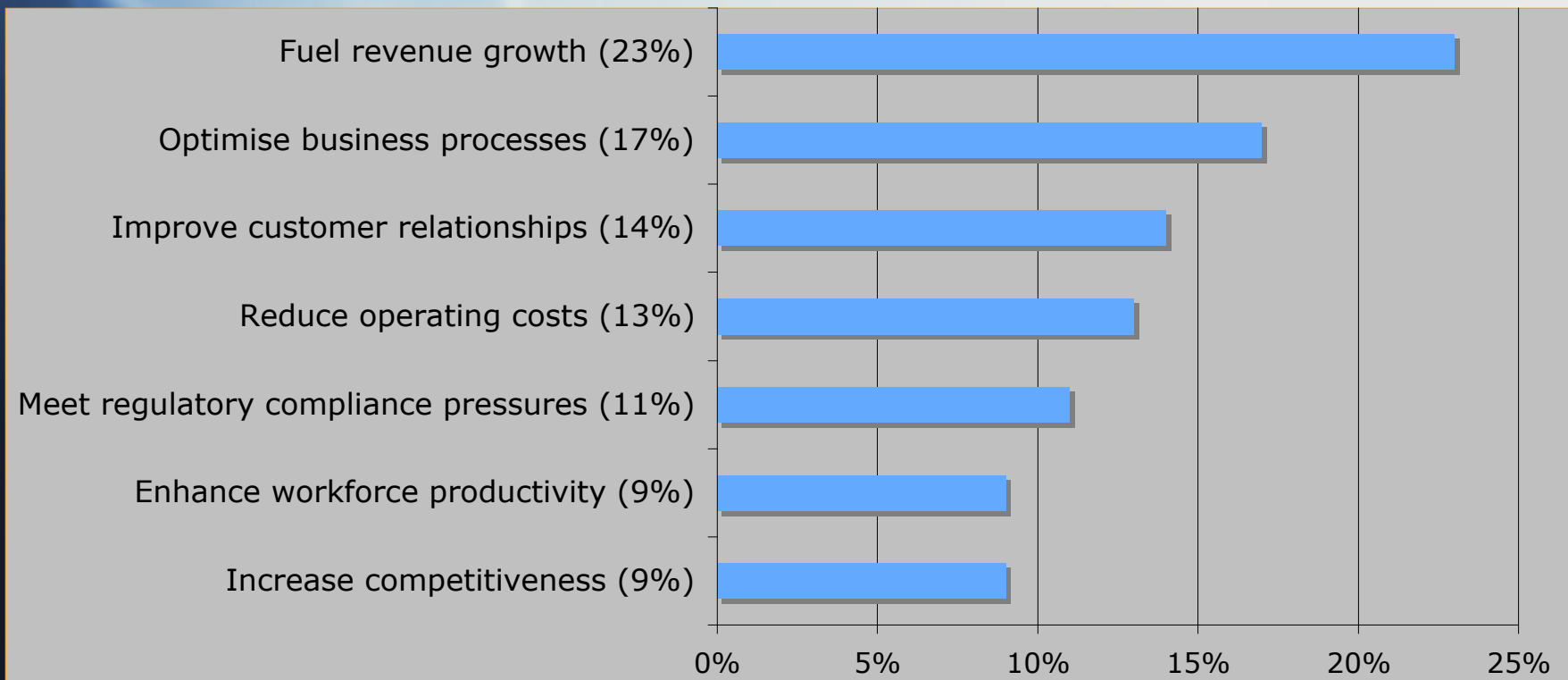
Senior IT management (19%)

Not aware of pressure (4%)

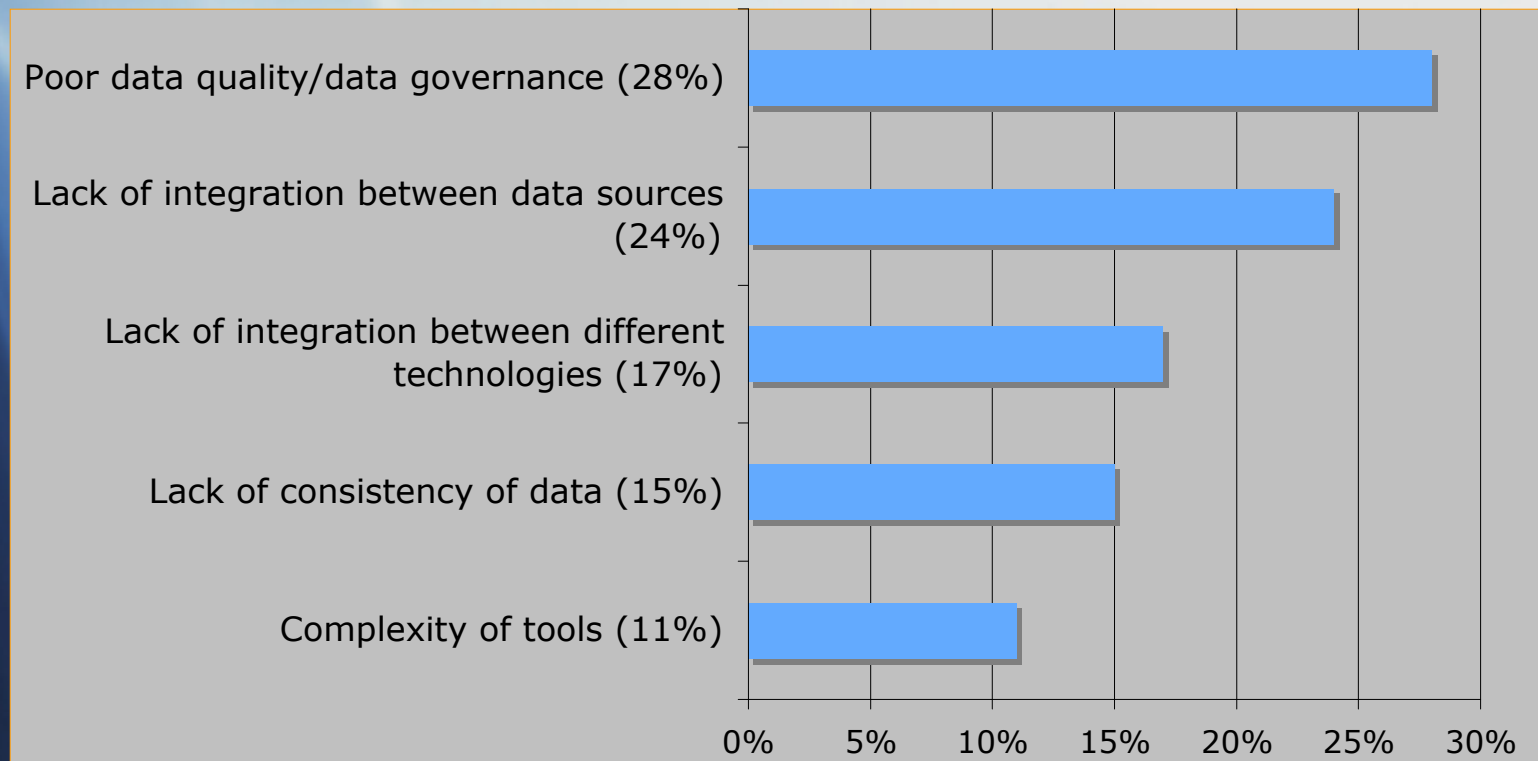
## DRIVERS FOR BETTER IM

- What is the most important driver for more effective information management within your organisation?



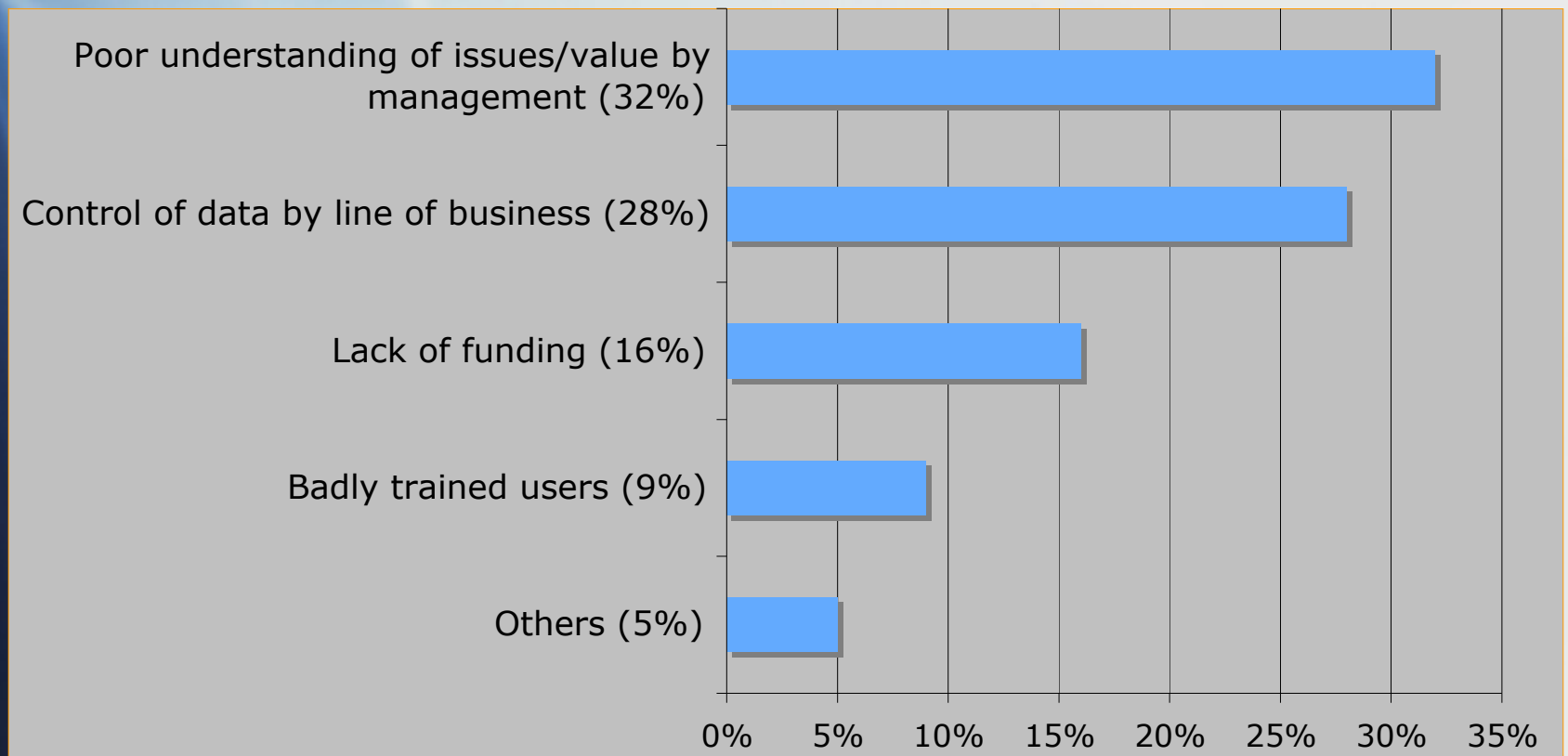
## TECHNOLOGY INHIBITORS

- What *technology factors* are inhibiting more effective information management within your organisation?



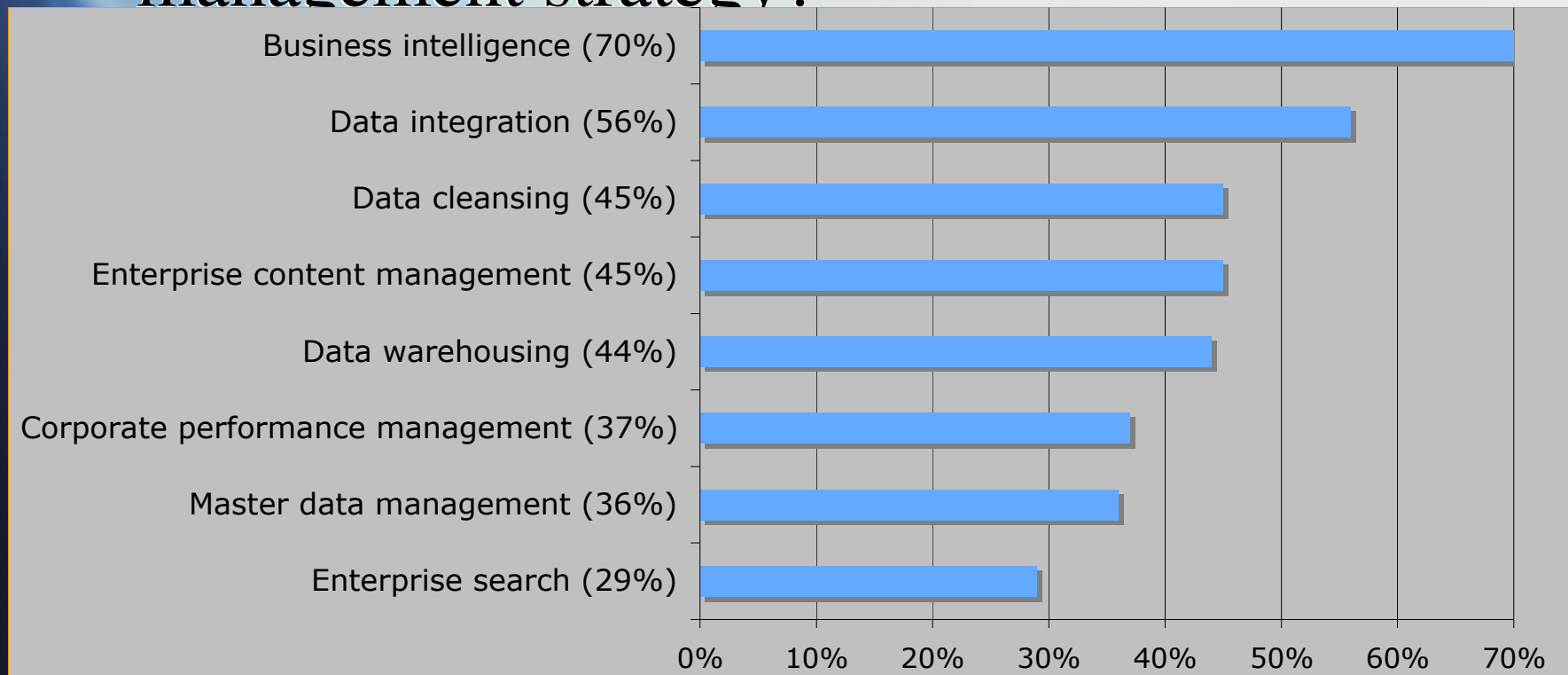
## BUSINESS INHIBITORS

- What *business factors* are inhibiting more effective information management within your organisation?



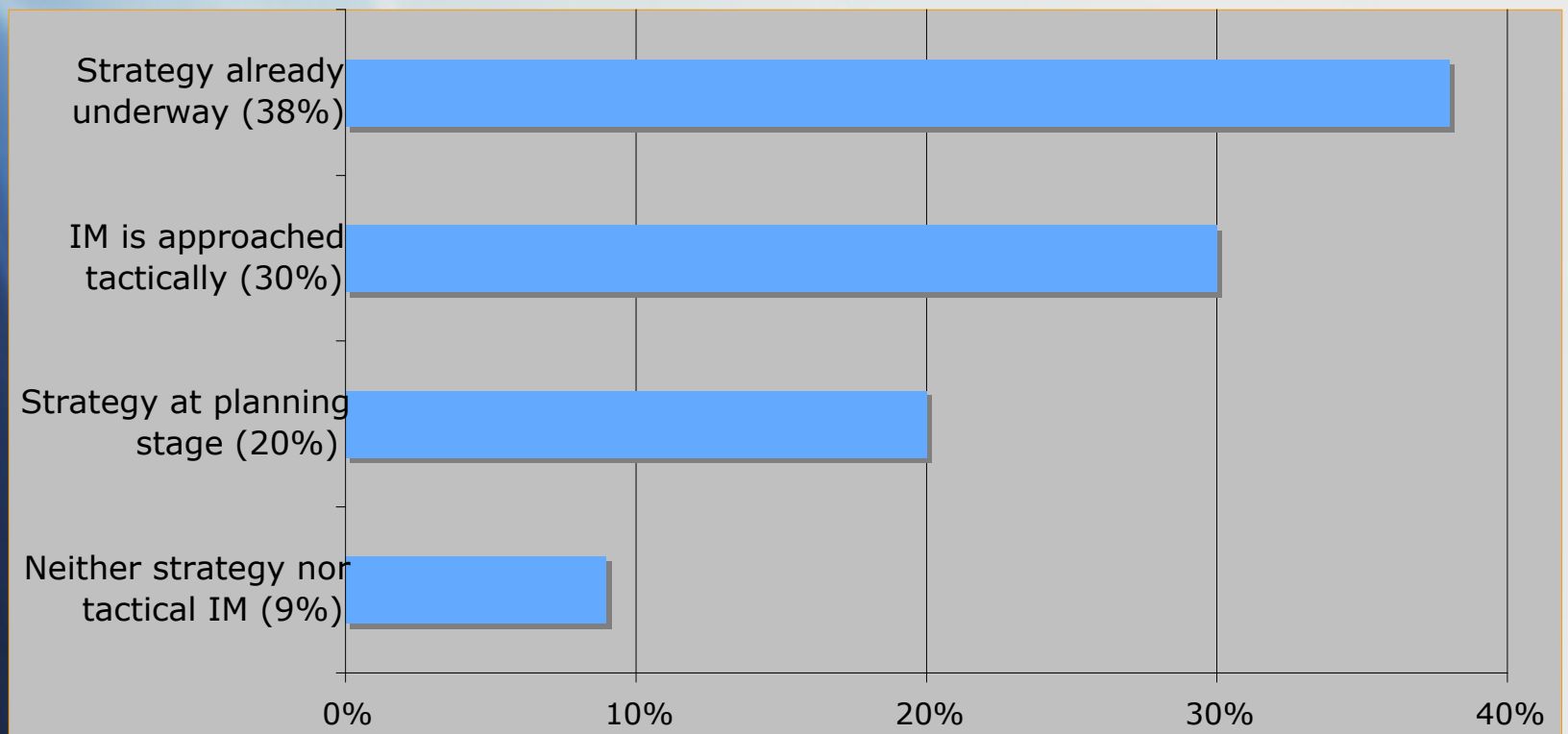
## INFORMATION ENABLERS

# LEVEL OF ENGAGEMENT

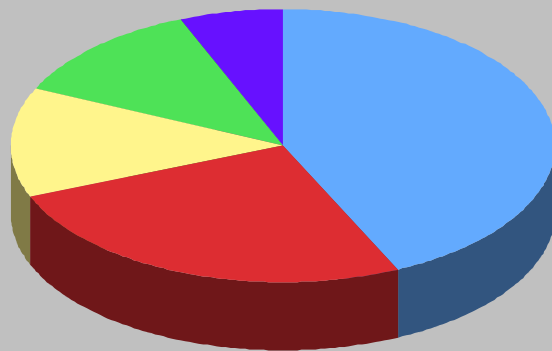
- To what extent does your organisation have a strategic focus on better information management?
