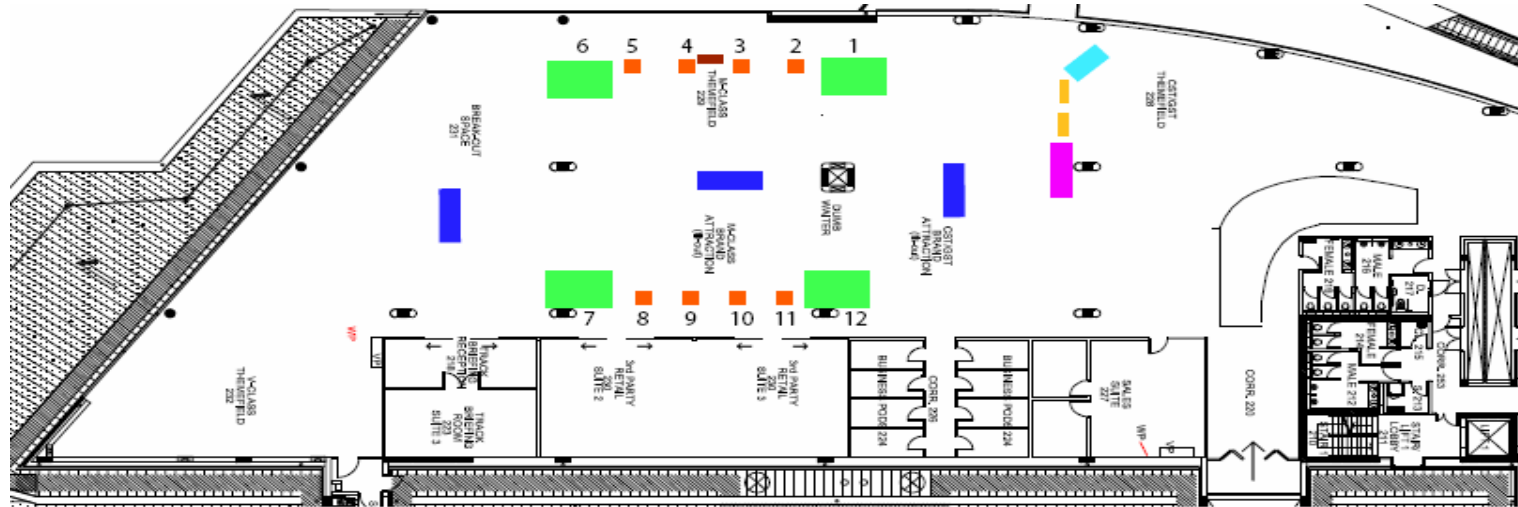


Passenger laps for all customers!
