TAKING CHARGE OF CHANGE

at the Emirates Stadium, London



Emirates Stadium is located at 75 Drayton Park, London N5 1BU

The Taking Charge of Change event will be held in the Royal Oak room. The entrance to the Royal Oak room is located at the North Entrance between gates E and D on the podium level. There is no parking available at the stadium. Travel by taxi or underground is recommended. Disabled access via the South Bridge on Drayton Park.

If you are travelling by taxi

Arrange for drop off at Highbury House, 75 Drayton Park, Emirates Stadium. Here you will find the entrance to the North Bridge which will take you directly over to the podium level and the North Entrance. The entrance to the Royal Oak is between gates E and D (blocks orange and blue on the map, right).

If you are travelling by London Underground

Arsenal Underground (Piccadilly Line) 3mins walk

Exit Arsenal station and turn right. Follow the road around to the right (Drayton Park). Walk approximately 100 metres and you will come to a green building on your right called 'Highbury House'. Walk up the steps under the Highbury House building and over the large pedestrian bridge. The entrance to the Royal Oak room will be directly in front of you between gates E & D.



Finsbury Park Underground (Victoria Line) 10-15mins walk

Exit Finsbury Park Station and turn right. Pass the Arsenal World of Sport shop on your right and cross the road at the pedestrian crossing. Directly in front of you is St. Thomas's Road. Pass the William Hill Bookmakers on your right and follow St. Thomas's Road round on the right. Walk down St. Thomas's Road for around 5 minutes and when you get to the end of the road turn right. Continue past Arsenal Underground station and follow the directions above from the Arsenal Underground Station.

If you are travelling by overland train

Kings Cross is the nearest mainline station for overland trains and is also served by all the main underground lines. From here you can get the Piccadilly Line to the Arsenal underground station, or alternatively an overland train to Finsbury Park which is a 10-15 minute walk.

From London Victoria, you can get the Victoria Line underground one stop to Green Park. Here you can change and get on the Piccadilly Line which will take you directly to Arsenal underground station.

From London Waterloo, get onto the Northern Line underground for four stops and change at Leicester Square. Here you can get on the Piccadilly line to Arsenal Underground station.
