Product Overview

IBM[®] WebSphere[®] Virtual Enterprise represents on demand capabilities in an extended environment. Use this product to enhance operational efficiency by deploying dynamic operations, service high-volume transactional workloads with linear scalability and near 100% availability, or manage large scale, continuously available WebSphere Application Server environments.

Additionally, WebSphere Virtual Enterprise provides application server virtualization, resource management, and a host of advanced operational facilities, such as performance visualization, health monitoring, and application versioning. New centralized workload management and health policy support has been added for PHP Hypertext Preprocessor (PHP) servers and support expanded for other application servers including workload management, application provisioning, health monitoring, and additional administration features. This will enable a more consistent approach to achieving service levels and health policies across a heterogeneous set of application servers.
