- WebSphere Developer for zSeries - Proof of Technology
 - How to code, test and debug a simple COBOL program (batch and CICS) without connection to the mainframe, using CICS Transaction Server for WebSphere Developer (CICS TS) that ships with WDz
 - How to code, compile and debug using COBOL or PL1 using a remote connection to z/OS, eliminating the need for TSO
 - How to create a Java Client from existing z/OS CICS COBOL programs using J2C connectors, then test on the workstation using CICS TS and CICS Transaction Gateway (CTG) that are delivered with WDz
 - How to transform and test existing COBOL programs to understand XML enabling service-oriented architecture (SOA) access to CICS Transaction Server and IMS.
 - How to create, test and debug z/OS DB2 Stored Procedures using COBOL or PL/1
 - How to generate and link COBOL programs from existing EGL programs, using Java Server Faces (JSF) infrastructure linking to back end COBOL processing
 - How to use the BMS Map Set Editor in WDz to create a map for an existing 3270 CICS COBOL application and then deploy and test the BMS map set using CICS TS
 - How to use the Service Flow Modeler (SFM) capability of WDz to create a business service that may be invoked as a Web service.
