Chapter 1. Small form-factor pluggable module option introduction

The IBM small form-factor pluggable (SFP) module option is required to connect a fiber-optic cable with an LC connector to a Fibre Channel device. SFP modules are hot-pluggable, which means that you can connect servers and storage devices to the arbitrated loop without turning off the mini-hub, switch, or any connected devices.

If you remove an SFP module from a mini-hub or switch port, that port is automatically bypassed. The remaining ports continue to operate normally without any degradation of system performance. Similarly, if you connect an SFP module to a mini-hub or switch, it automatically becomes a node on the loop when valid Fibre Channel communication data is received from the connected device.

One of the following two types of SFP modules comes with this option: plastic tab and wire.




Figure 1. SFP module plastic tab variety





Figure 2. SFP module wire variety

Chapter 2. Installation and removal instructions

Installing an SFP

Use the following procedure to install an SFP module.





Figure 3. SFP protective cap

1. For both the wire variety and plastic tab variety SFPs, remove the protective cap from the SFP module, as shown in Figure 3.




Figure 5. Plastic tab variety SFP module installed in a switch

2. Carefully slide the SFP module into a mini-hub or switch, as shown in Figure 4 on page 4 and Figure 5 on page 4.



Note: You might need to remove a protective cap from the node before you can insert the SFP module.

Figure 4. Plastic tab variety SFP installed in a FAStT900 mini-hub




Figure 6. Wire variety SFP module installed in a FAStT600 controller

Attention: To avoid damage to your fiber-optic interface cables, follow these guidelines:

- Do not route the cable along a folding cable-management arm.
- For devices on slide rails, leave enough slack in the cable so that it does not bend to a radius less than 38 mm (1.5 in.) when extended or become pinched when retracted.
- Route the cable away from areas where it can be damaged by other devices in the rack cabinet.
- Do not use plastic cable ties in place of the cable straps that are provided.
- Do not overtighten the cable straps or bend the cables to a radius less than 38 mm (1.5 in.).
- Do not put excess weight on the cable at the connection point. Be sure that the cable is well supported.
- 3. Plug a fiber-optic cable LC connector into the SFP module. Refer to the documentation that comes with your fiber-optic cable for detailed information.

Removing an SFP

Use the following procedure to remove an SFP module:

Attention: To avoid damage to the cable or to the SFP module, make sure you unplug the LC-LC Fibre Channel cable *before* you remove the SFP module.

- 1. Remove the fiber-optic cable from the SFP module; then, replace the protective caps on the cable connector.
- 2. Unlock the SFP module latch:




Figure 7. Unlocking the SFP module latch - plastic tab variety

 - For SFP modules with plastic tabs, unlock the SFP module latch by pulling the plastic tab outward 10° while you remove the SFP module, as shown in Figure 7 on page 6.




Figure 8. Unlocking the SFP module latch - wire tab variety

• For SFP modules with wire tabs, unlock the SFP module latch by pulling the wire latch outward 90°, as shown in Figure 8.

3. Replace the protective cap on the SFP module.



The warranties provided by IBM in this Statement of Limited Warranty apply only to Machines you purchase for your use, and not for resale, from IBM or your reseller. The term "Machine" means an IBM machine, its features, conversions, upgrades, elements, or accessories, or any combination of them. The term "Machine" does not include any software programs, whether pre-loaded with the Machine, installed subsequently or otherwise. Unless IBM specifies otherwise, the following warranties apply only in the country where you acquire the Machine. Nothing in this Statement of Limited Warranty affects any statutory rights of consumers that cannot be waived or limited by contract. If you have any questions, contact IBM or your reseller.

The IBM Warranty for Machines

IBM warrants that each Machine 1) is free from defects in materials and workmanship and 2) conforms to IBM's Official Published Specifications ("Specifications"). The warranty period for a Machine is a specified, fixed period commencing on its Date of Installation. The date on your sales receipt is the Date of Installation unless IBM or your reseller informs you otherwise.

If a Machine does not function as warranted during the warranty period, and IBM or your reseller are unable to either 1) make it do so or 2) replace it with one that is at least functionally equivalent, you may return it to your place of purchase and your money will be refunded.

Extent of Warranty

The warranty does not cover the repair or exchange of a Machine resulting from misuse, accident, modification, unsuitable physical or operating environment,

improper maintenance by you, or failure caused by a product for which IBM is not responsible. The warranty is voided by removal or alteration of Machine or parts identification labels.

Items Not Covered by Warranty

IBM does not warrant uninterrupted or error-free operation of a Machine.

Any technical or other support provided for a Machine under warranty, such as assistance via telephone with "how-to" questions and those regarding Machine set-up and installation, will be provided **WITHOUT WARRANTIES OF ANY KIND**.

Warranty Service

To obtain warranty service for a Machine, contact IBM or your reseller. If you do not register your Machine with IBM, you may be required to present proof of purchase.

During the warranty period, IBM or your reseller, if approved by IBM to provide warranty service, provides without charge certain types of repair and exchange service to keep Machines in, or restore them to, conformance with their Specifications. IBM or your reseller will inform you of the available types of service for a Machine based on its country of installation. At its discretion, IBM or your reseller will 1) either repair or exchange the failing Machine and 2) provide the service either at your location or a service center. Governing Law: The following replaces "laws of the country in which you acquired the Machine" in the first sentence: laws in the Province of Ontario.

UNITED STATES

Governing Law: The following replaces "laws of the country in which you acquired the Machine" in the first sentence: laws of the State of New York.

ASIA PACIFIC

AUSTRALIA

The IBM Warranty for Machines: *The following paragraph is added to this Section:* The warranties specified in this Section are in addition to any rights you may have under the Trade Practices Act 1974 or other similar legislation and are only limited to the extent permitted by the applicable legislation.

Limitation of Liability: *The following is added to this Section:* Where IBM is in breach of a condition or warranty implied by the Trade Practices Act 1974 or other similar legislation, IBM's liability is limited to the repair or replacement of the goods or the supply of equivalent goods. Where that condition or warranty relates to right to sell, quiet possession or clear title, or the goods are of a kind ordinarily acquired for personal, domestic or household use or consumption, then none of the limitations in this paragraph apply.

The following is added to this Section: Disputes and differences arising out of or in connection with this Agreement shall be finally settled by arbitration which shall be held in Singapore in accordance with the rules of the International Chamber of Commerce (ICC). The arbitrator or arbitrators designated in conformity with those rules shall have the power to rule on their own competence and on the validity of the Agreement to submit to arbitration. The arbitration award shall be final and binding for the parties without appeal and the arbitral award shall be in writing and set forth the findings of fact and the conclusions of law.

Proceedings shall continue from the stage they were at when the vacancy occurred.

If one of the parties refuses or otherwise fails to appoint an arbitrator within 30 days of the date the other party appoints its, the first appointed arbitrator shall be the sole arbitrator, provided that the arbitrator was validly and properly appointed.

The English language version of this Agreement prevails over any other language version.

HONG KONG AND MACAU

Governing Law: The following replaces "laws of the country in which you acquired the Machine" in the first sentence: laws of Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.

INDIA

Limitation of Liability: The following replaces items 1 and 2 of this Section:

- 1. liability for bodily injury (including death) or damage to real property and tangible personal property will be limited to that caused by IBM's negligence;

Any disputes arising from or in connection with this Agreement will first be resolved by friendly negotiations, failing which either of us has the right to submit the dispute to the China International Economic and Trade Arbitration Commission in Beijing, the PRC, for arbitration in accordance with its arbitration rules in force at the time. The arbitration tribunal will consist of three arbitrators. The language to be used therein will be English and Chinese. An arbitral award will be final and binding on all the parties, and will be enforceable under the Convention on the Recognition and Enforcement of Foreign Arbitral Awards (1958).

The arbitration fee will be borne by the losing party unless otherwise determined by the arbitral award.

During the course of arbitration, this Agreement will continue to be performed except for the part which the parties are disputing and which is undergoing arbitration.
