Pre-requisites

Review all instructions before starting install of the DB2 Web Query Software Development Kit (SDK) licensed products. If you have not already installed the prerequisite DB2 Web Query V1R1M1 licensed product (5733-QU2), follow the links on the DB2 Web Query getting started web site:

http://www.ibm.com/systems/i/software/db2/webquery/gettingstarted.html Please follow the instructions to install and configure V1R1M1. The V1R1M0 release of DB2 Web Query will not support the SDK.

In addition, the following pre-requisite PTFs are required for the DB2 Web Query license product (5733-QU2) in order the Software Development Kit APIs to work. Please make sure that Web Query is STOPPED prior to loading these PTFs by using ENDWEBQRY.

To install, sign on as QSECOFR or a user with *SECADM or *ALLOBJ authority.

Software Development Kit (SDK) Installation:

- 1) RSTLICPGM LICPGM(5733QU4) DEV(OPT01) // Replace OPT01 with you optical device
- 2) Read and press F14 to accept the licensed agreement
- 3) If you have the license key for this product, issue the ADDLICKEY.
- 4) STRWEBQRY restarting DB2 WebQuery Services

Considerations for the use of SDK:

A download version of the SDK API documentation is provided at the DB2 Web Query getting started web site:

http://www.ibm.com/systems/i/software/db2/webquery/gettingstarted.html This document describes the web services, the Web Query APIs, Report Broker APIs and the structures necessary to interface with these services.

Use of the SDK also requires the install and license of the Run Time User Enablement option, 5733QU2 DB2 Web Query Option 4.

Note to DB2 Web Query Administrators:

In previous DB2 Web Query instructions the issuer of the STRWEBQRY and ENDWEBQRY CL commands was directed to log on as QWEBQRYADM so the requester was assured the appropriate authority to start and end the servers. With the above listed DB2 Web Query pre-requisite PTFs, these two CL commands are now installed with PUBLIC *EXCLUDE to afford you better control over the start or end of Web Query servers. In addition, these commands now adopt the necessary authority for Web Query services without requiring a logon as QWEBQRYADM.

Note to SDK Beta users:

A number of new language translations were provided as part of the Beta program to get feedback from the various geographies interested in DB2 Web Query and SDK. This translation work is nearing completion but was not finished in time for the scheduled availability of the SDK services. Those new language translations are not included in the pre-requisite PTFs listed above. Please look for a follow on PTF in early October '08 to include these new languages.
