What is the Administration Runtime Expert?

- The Administration Runtime Expert (ARE) allows you to
 - · Identify an extensive set of attributes that you want to ensure don't change
 - · Run a verification to ensure those attributes have not changed
 - · Review reports on the results of the verification
 - · Automatically correct a subset of errors
 - · Distribute, and optionally apply, PTFs to groups of systems
 - Extend the IBM-provided functionality with your own custom plug-ins



Why use the Administration Runtime Expert (ARE)?

- · Identify attributes that may have changed on a single partition
- Ensure consistency across multiple partitions
 - Environmental settings
 - Application attributes
 - Security settings
- · Identify differences between test and production environments
- · Track changes to show nothing has changed for audit and compliance requirements
- Ensure PTF consistency
- · Distribute and optionally load and apply PTFs
- · ... and many more



Attributes that can be Verified

- Application attributes
 - Existence, authorities, any attribute applicable to the object
 - Contents of configuration files
- Products and PTFs
- TCP/IP Configuration and ports
- System values and network attributes, system environment variables
- User Profiles

- Anything you can verify with SQL, CL, or Shell commands
- Anything else with custom plug-ins



Overview of ARE



ARE Installation

- ARE consists of two parts:
 - 5733-ARE
 - This product is required to be installed on the central system
 - · The ARE LPP provides the graphical user interface
 - · You can find the version of the console on the main web page
 - ARE runtime engine (also called the ARE core)
 - · Shipped with the operating system
 - · Used on the endpoints to run verifications



Central System: the ARE Template Editor and Console


- · 5733-ARE only needs to be installed on partitions where the GUI will be used
 - · Create and edit deployment templates
 - · Define target systems and groups
 - Initiate manual verifications
 - Schedule automated verifications
 - Review reports
 - Execute fix actions





ARE Runtime Engine and Target Systems

- · The ARE runtime engine is a set of Java classes used for doing the validation
 - IBM documentation refers to this runtime engine as the ARE core
- · Shipped as part of the base operating system
 - 5733-ARE is not required on target systems





Installation and Setup of ARE

- Install 5733-ARE on the central system
- · Ensure required ports are available
 - 12401 on the central system
 - · Host servers on endpoint systems
- The ARE Console runs in the IBMARE web application server in the QHTTPSVR subsystem
 - · QSYS/STRTCPSVR SERVER(*HTTP) HTTPSVR(IBMARE)







Authority for the ARE Web Console

- · ARE user interface requires *ALLOBJ special authority
 - Building a template requires access to many resources
- Using Web Administration for i, you can grant permission for any user to create templates or run verifications









Add Permissions

- Operator
 - · Basic capabilities: view, start and stop a server
- Developer
 - · Allowed to create, build, copy, delete, edit, export, import, rename a template
 - Not allowed to test the template

 - · Don't let your ARE session timeout when working a template!



Template Considerations

- · Iterative process to develop templates
- Start simple
 - · Add attributes as identified by day-to-day systems management or problem determination
- · Develop custom plugins to verify attributes not supported by ARE template editor
 - Some examples:
 - Check NetServer file shares
 - Check Collection Services configuration
 - · Prestart job statistics versus prestart job tuning parameters
 - The possibilities are endless
- · Templates are never done
 - · Like performance tuning, review your templates and modify as the environment or applications change






Central System and PTF Images

- · Central System can distribute PTFs via save files or image catalog
 - Save files require the central system only distribute PTFs to target systems at the same release
 - With an image catalog, the Central System can distribute PTFs to groups of systems of different releases



PTF Fix Actions

- The fix action will try to do one of these things:
 - · Load and apply the fix from a special device name QIBMAREPTF
 - The QIBMAREPTF device needs to be manually created when the virtual optical device is setup on the target system
 - · Send and apply the fix from a central system through use of *SAVF
 - The save files are located in QGPL/Q<ptf_id> and PTF save files remain on the target system after the PTF is installed
 - For Group PTFs, the save files are located in QGPL/Q<group_ptf_id> and Group PTF save files are deleted after they have been installed on the target system as they don't need to exist long term
- · Neither of these requires Internet access





Custom Plug-ins



Custom Plugins

- · Built-in features of ARE are very powerful
- · But you may need to write your own custom plugins for unique verifications
 - · Can also build in your own fix actions

- · ARE plugins are written in Java
- · ARE provides sample plugins at
 - · /QIBM/UserData/ARE/samples/sample.jar
 - · sample.jar is a valid deployment template
 - · Source is included in the jar file




Example Plugins

- Check on NetServer File Shares
 - · Report shares and permissions and flag errors if root or /QIBM are shared
 - Java Toolbox: ISeriesNetServer and ISeriesNetServerFileShare
 - IBM i Service QSYS2.SERVER_SHARE_INFO
- Tune Prestart Job Entries
 - Adjust the INLJOBS parameter on prestart job entries dynamically to reflect actual workloads
 - Use QSYS2. PRESTART_JOB_INFO and QSYS2.PRESTART_JOB_STATISTICS
