

IBM i 7.1 on selected Power S922 and E980 servers

Prior to November 2020, IBM i 7.1 has not been available on servers with IBM POWER9 technology-based processors. Now an IBM i 7.1 Activation is available on the following servers with these specific configurations:

- Power Systems S922 (9009-22A) requires a Virtual I/O Server (VIOS), and the IBM i partitions must be set to restricted I/O mode. The Power Systems S922 (9009-22A) with the 4-core processor is not supported with IBM i.
- Power Systems S922 (9009-22G) requires VIOS, and the IBM i partitions must be set to restricted I/O mode. The Power Systems S922 (9009-22G) with the 4-core processor is not supported with IBM i. The Power Systems S922 (9009-22G) with the 1-core processor will not support the IBM i 7.1 activation.
- Power Systems E980 (9080-M9S) requires VIOS, and the IBM i 7.1 partitions must be set to restricted I/O mode.

The IBM i 7.1 Activation is a hardware feature that enables IBM i 7.1 to install and run on the Power S922 and Power E980 servers. The IBM i 7.1 Activation hardware feature does not change any IBM i software ordering behavior in e-config.

Steps to order the IBM i 7.1 Activation on the S922A, S922G, and E980:

For both initial orders and MES orders, the IBM i 7.1 Activation feature is on the "Order Codes" display. The IBM i 7.1 Activation feature will generate a hardware activation code. Upon order fulfillment, retrieve the hardware activation code from [Power Systems Capacity on Demand](#).

For new orders of the Power S922 or Power E980 server where the IBM i 7.1 Activation is desired, order the IBM i 7.1 Activation hardware feature. For the IBM i software order on those servers, order either a currently supported release of IBM i, which is 7.3, or later, or order IBM i 7.2 through the withdrawn order path. For IBM i entitlement transfers to a Power S922 or Power E980 server, if a client's IBM i entitlement on the donor machine is at IBM i 7.2, or earlier, the entitlement will be upgraded to IBM i 7.3 or IBM i 7.4 upon transfer to the Power S922 or the Power E980.

For existing Power S922 or Power E980 servers, order the IBM i 7.1 Activation hardware feature.

The IBM i 7.1 Activation feature codes:

- EB3U for the S922G and S922A
- EB3V for the E980

Steps to acquire IBM i 7.1 programs if needed and software keys:

As for acquiring IBM i 7.1 software keys and software downloads on the Power S922 or Power E980 server, as long as a client has active IBM i SWMA, clients can get previous-release keys and previous-release software downloads of IBM i, as well as their entitled Licensed Program Products for IBM i and IBM i optional features, from [Entitled System Support](#) (ESS). This is the standard process for IBM i clients to acquire previous-release keys and software. If clients have active SWMA but do not see IBM i 7.1 keys for their entitled software on ESS, contact the Key Center at WWSWKEYS@dk.ibm.com.

Installation notes and prerequisites:

- Apply FW950 (which was generally available November, 2020)
- The IBM i 7.1 partitions must be set to restricted I/O mode. For information regarding restricted I/O mode, see [IBM Documentation "Changing Advanced Partition Settings"](#).
- Note that there is no support for any IBM i 7.1 configurations with NVMe internal storage. No new load source types were added and in particular, 4096-byte-sector vSCSI devices are not supported even though they may appear as choices on the load-source selection screen. Attempting to use these devices will cause a failure with SRC B6005122.
- Prior to installing the PTFs above, ensure the partition is not in POWER7 compatibility mode (refer to Partition properties > Processors > Advanced)
- Retrieve the hardware activation code from [Power Systems Capacity on Demand](#) and apply it via an HMC
- Install the Technology Refresh level, cumulative PTF package, and other PTFs as listed above.

1. What are the plans for IBM i 7.1 Service Extension?

2. Can a client acquire an IBM i 7.1 Activation for the other Power Systems servers: e.g. S914, S922G with 1-core processor, S924?

Answer: There are no plans to support IBM i 7.1 on Power Systems servers other than the S922A, S922G (not on the 1-core and 4-core processor features), and the E980. If you want to provide input to IBM, submit a [Request for Enhancement \(RFE\)](#).

3. Is there a cost associated with the IBM i 7.1 Activation feature?

Answer: Yes. The following are the list prices in USD.

Feature EB3U for S922A and S922G: \$1,000

Feature EB3V for E980: \$1,500

IBM's prices are subject to change without notice.

4. Is the IBM i 7.1 Activation valid in the Power Enterprise Pools 2.0 environment?

Answer: No. Only IBM i 7.2 and later are supported in Power Enterprise Pools 2.0 and only the S922G and E980 models.

5. Is IBM i 7.1 available in the Power Systems Virtual Server (VS) offering?

Answer: Yes, this was rolled out starting February, 2021.

6. Where do I get the IBM i 7.1 Activation VET code?

Answer: [Power Systems Capacity on Demand](#)

7. Is native I/O support available for any offering of IBM i 7.1 on a Power Systems Server with POWER9 technology?

Answer: No. Only the S922A, S922G, and E980 have any support for IBM i 7.1, and VIOS is required for all I/O.

8. Is Live Partition Mobility (LPM) available with IBM i 7.1 on the S922A, S922G, and the E980?

Answer: LPM is available in IBM i 7.1 TR4 and later (since 2012) and therefore is available on the S922A, S922G, and E980 systems.
