





cotta on a component indicates that the component can be hot-swapped. Hot-swap means that if the system, operating system, and configuration all support hot-swap capability, you can remove or install the component while the system is running.

Blue on a component indicates touch points. Touch points are where you can grip the component to remove or install it from the system, open or close a latch, and so on.











When installing a second microprocessor, be sure to install a VRM.
