Workflow library

Lenovo XClarity Integrator for VMware vRealize Orchestrator provides a workflow library that allows you to run automated processes related to the management of Lenovo XClarity Administrator instances. Standard workflows allow you to secure an available server for provisioning, apply a configuration pattern, and deploy EXSi on the server. Sample workflows demonstrate how to combine standard workflows to create more complex ones, such as adding a bare-metal server to vCenter cluster in one step.
